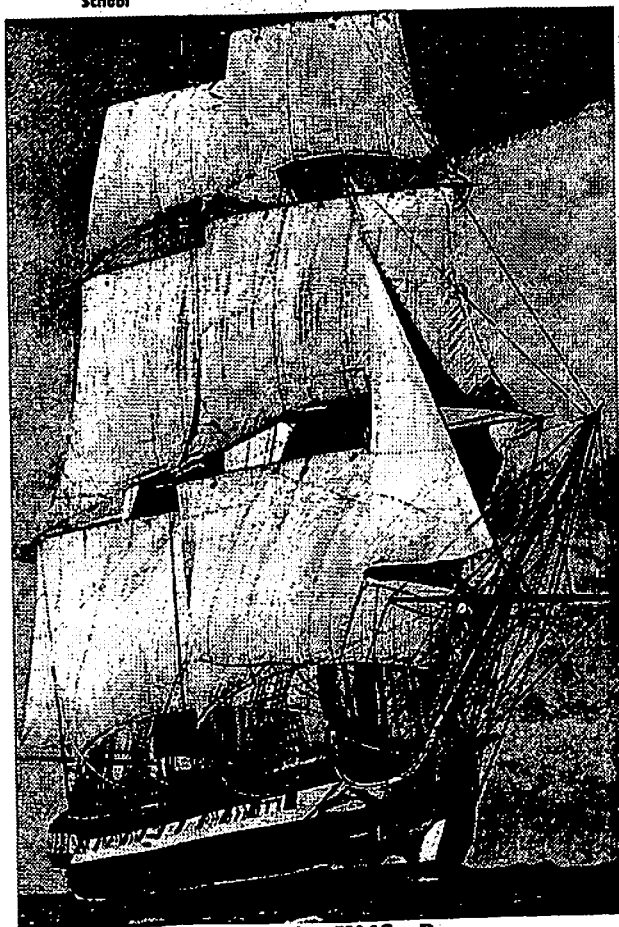

Tour the Tall Ship *Rose*

The largest wooden tall ship, the *HMS Rose*, will sail into Snug Harbor Friday, May 15 at approximately 3:15 pm, for opening festivities of the new Duxbury Bay Maritime School (DBMS). A community wide celebration is planned featuring tours of the *Rose*.

entertainment and activities on Saturday, May 16 from 10 am to 3 pm and Sunday, May 17 from 12 noon until 3 pm at the town pier at the William P. Ellison Campus of the DBMS. The tall ship event is sponsored by Ocean Spray, Dunkin' Donuts (of Duxbury and Plymouth) and Janney Montgomery Scott.

Activities Scheduled

The DHS marching band will greet the arrival of the *Rose* on Friday afternoon as it sails into the bay and docks. The Saturday Anchors Aweigh Family Festival will feature the High School Jazz Band from 10 am until 12 noon. Duxbury's Watson Reid & Americana will perform from 12 noon until 2 pm, and WATD will broadcast live all day.

Other scheduled activities throughout the day Saturday include a display of the new DBMS fleet, ship building demonstrations by high school students, a boat building display by Jeff Grey and knot tying demonstrations by Louis Richardi of the International Guild of Knot Tying. A silent auction will be held and refreshments will be available throughout the weekend.

Tours and Parking

Tours onboard the *Rose* are \$5 per person or \$10 per family and are open to the public. Parking is available at Battelle on Washington St. Additional parking is available at the high school with a shuttle service to Snug Harbor available on Saturday.
