MARY EDDY, 60

Mary (Howland) Eddy, 60, of Duxbury, died Nov. 23, at home after a long illness. A lifelong resident of Duxbury, Mary was educated in Duxbury schools and was a graduate of Dale Academy, a hairdressing school in Boston. She was the

daughter of the late Roger and Ethel (Hill) Howland.

Mary and her mother, who was also called "Larri", also a hairdresser, opened a salon named "Larri's Hairstyles" in 1963. Located in the Rockland Trust Building on Bay Rd., it is still in business. Mary enjoyed working with her mother and became the sole proprietor after "Larri's" death several years ago.

In addition to hairdressing, Mary had a lifelong love of gardening. From spring to fall,

there was a variety of colorful flowers blooming in the gardens around her house. She was a talented flower arranger. The salon was decorated with artistic bouquets which the clients enjoyed, as Mary shared her talent with them. She lived at the "Howland Farm" off Bay Rd. Started by her great-grandfather at the turn of the century, she continued the tradition of growing and selling raspberries and peaches. Customers would wait in line as the crops came in each year.
