More Work Underway at Winsor House

Work is underway at the Nathaniel Winsor Jr. House on Washington Sstreet, the future site of the Duxbury Rural and Historical Society's main office. The project will create an accessible entrance for persons with disabilities. It is anticipated that much of the work will be completed by the end of June.

The majority of the work consists of the relocation of the driveway to allow for additional parking spaces and a handicapped van accessible space. A walkway is under construction that will lead from the handicapped parking space to the new accessible entrance on the east veranda. The veranda will be accessed by means of a small 6-foot ramp.

The project has required the temporary removal of the garden on the south lawn. The plants have been preserved and will be replaced when the new walkway is completed.

The Nathaniel Winsor Jr. House, an example of Federal period architecture, was built by a prominent Duxbury shipowner in 1807.
