Residents of two **Duxbury** neighborhoods are seeking to ban trucks from their roads after a series of minor accidents. Complaints about truck traffic in the areas around Lincoln and Cross streets were discussed by town officials last week. "The problem is that the town is 95 percent residential," town manager Rocco Longo said last week. "But when you ban trucks from one part of town, it becomes a Catch 22 because they get moved to another neighborhood. We must be careful and realize this is not a problem that gets solved overnight." John Shea, chairman of the public safety advisory committee, said his group has recommended increased law enforcement in the area and will continue to monitor those roads.
