The Alden House Museum, the ancestral home of John and Priscilla (Mullins) Alden, has been an historical and architectural treasure of Duxbury since it was built in 1653. Thousands of Duxbury children over the years have visited the Alden House. Thousands come each year from every state.

As you may be well aware, the Alden Kindred of America, Inc., has constructed a timber frame barn near the house, on the site of a former barn. Many residents attended the barnraising a year ago and others have dropped in to check on its progress.

It is nearly complete - a few thousand dollars more will do it. We want everyone in Duxbury to have a chance to participate and themselves become a part of the Alden Museum's long and fascinating history. You can do this for the price of a meal in a good restaurant, thirty-five dollars per customized brick.

Until May 15th, you can have one or more specially engraved bricks made up. These will be placed in the walkways around the house and barn where they will be seen everyone who visits our museum. What a treat it will be to take your guests to the Alden House and show them "your brick." And you can even order duplicate bricks for yourself.
