The Duxbury Yacht Club was incorporated in 1895. The club house was built at the Standish Shore, which was occupied by the club two years. Desiring a more central location, a new house was built in 1897 by Cassius M. Hunt, which was leased by the club for a term of years. The club is in a flourishing condition, having a membership of over one hundred. During the season there are several regattas, and several new yachts have been added this year.
