The historic Paul Seabury House circa (1757-1762) in Tinkertown was demolished Tuesday. Attempts to preserve the structure or find someone to purchase the house failed following a six month expiration of the first demolition delay order issued in town by the Duxbury Historic Commission. The historic house had fallen into a state of disrepair and new owners of the property determined they wanted to build a new 5 bedroom colonial set back on the property instead of restoring the house.
