**Plymouth Five Cents Savings Bank Duxbury Branch—Halls Corner, South Duxbury**



June Eldridge, daughter of Mr. and Mrs. Carl Eldridge of Surplus St., is teller of the new Duxbury bank that opened for business at Hall's Corner on March 30. The gentleman on the right is George Carter of Plymouth, who is bank manager. The Duxbury bank, which offers the same services as the Plymouth Five Cents Savings Bank in Plymouth, is the first one since the "Duxbury Bank" that operated from 1833 to 1842, when Duxbury was a ship-building centre. A check drawn by Daniel Webster on the original bank is preserved at the Duxbury Rural and Historical Society.
