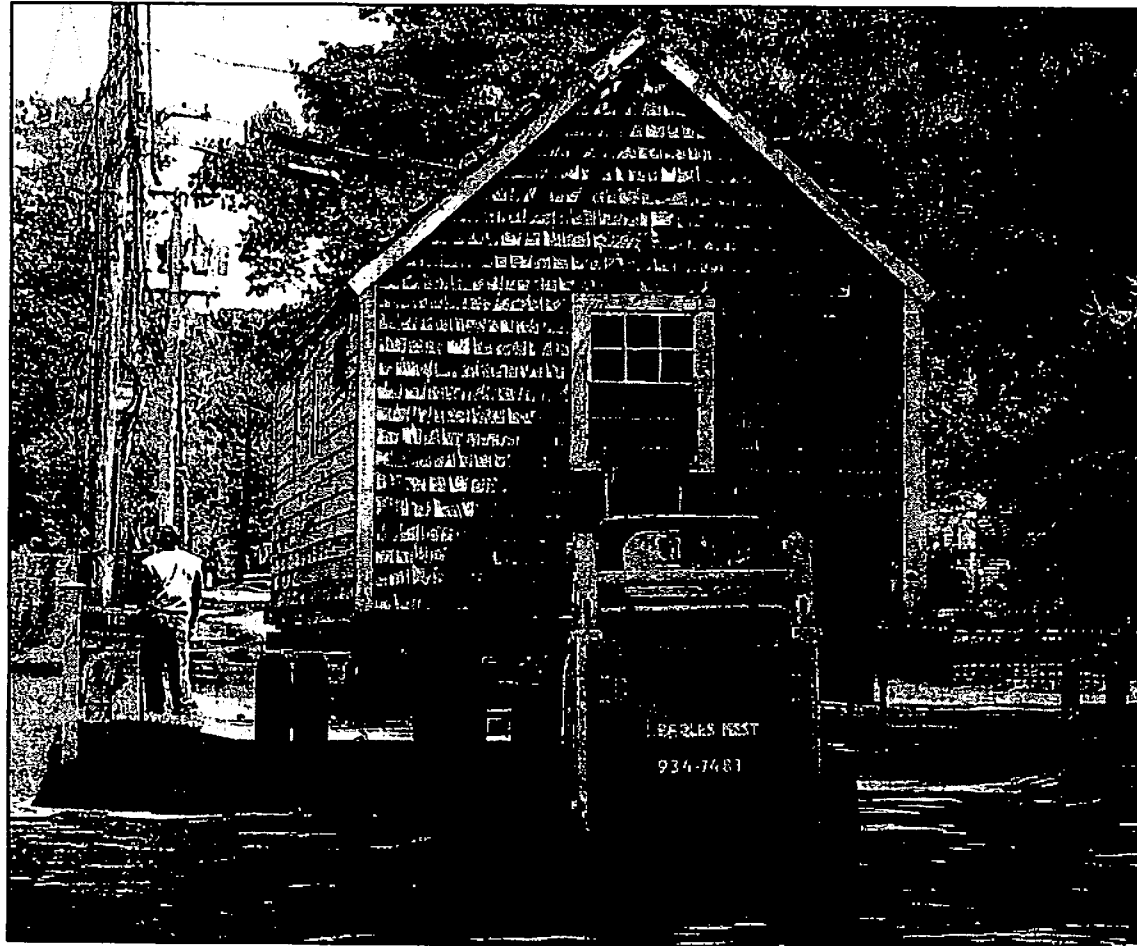


KING CAESAR HOUSE
