Racers took a course that took them from the pavilion parking lot down to the second crossover and back.

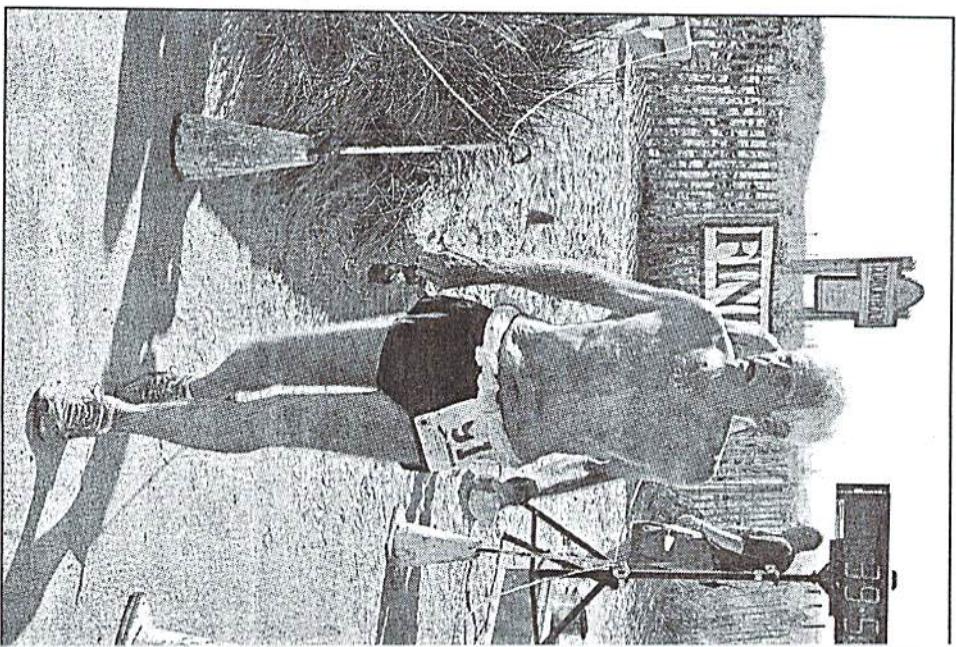

Ashley Szafram is proud to run the last few feet of the Duxbury 5K Beach Race with her mom, Kerri.



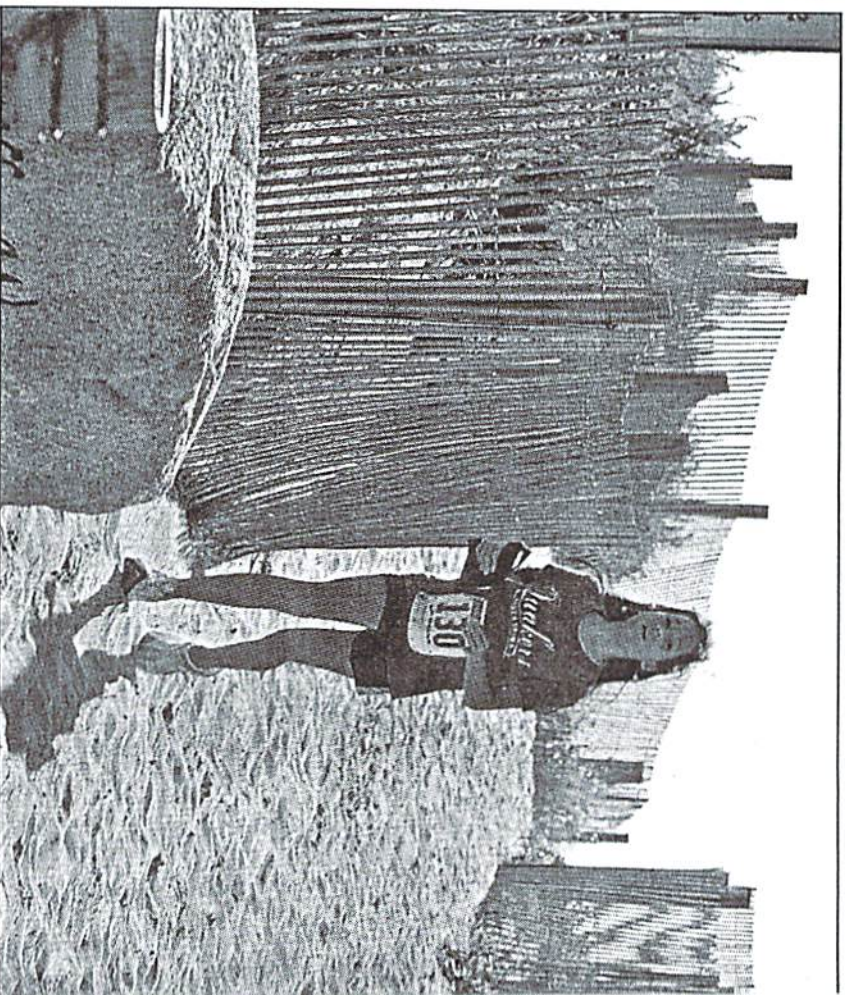
