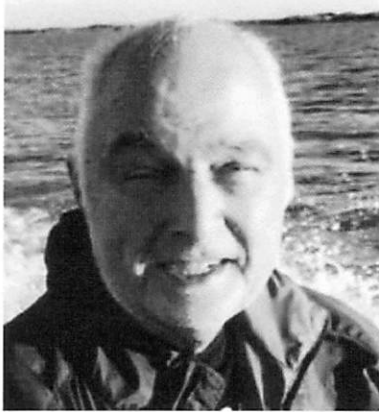


Robert J. Weatherbee, 76
