Duxbury Art Display to Honor Helen Bumpus

A reception will be held tomorrow afternoon from 5 until 7 o'clock to mark the opening of an exhibition in honor of Helen M. Bumpus of the class of 1913, Smith College, at the Helen Bumpus Gallery in the Duxbury Free Library.

Featured in the exhibit, on loan from the Smith College Museum of Art, will be a collection of the etchings and lithographs of James Abbott McNeil Whistler. Also shown will be 19th and 20th century American and French paintings and drawings by such artists as Jason Berger, Ralph Blakelock, Hyman Bloom, Homer Dodge Martin, Adolphe Monticelli, Dwight Tyron and Alexander Wyant.

The exhibit will be open to the public Monday, Aug. 11, through Sunday, Sept. 7. Hours are Monday and Wednesday afternoons, 2 to 8 o'clock, Tuesdays and Thursdays, 10 until 8 o'clock, and Saturdays, 10 to 6 o'clock.
