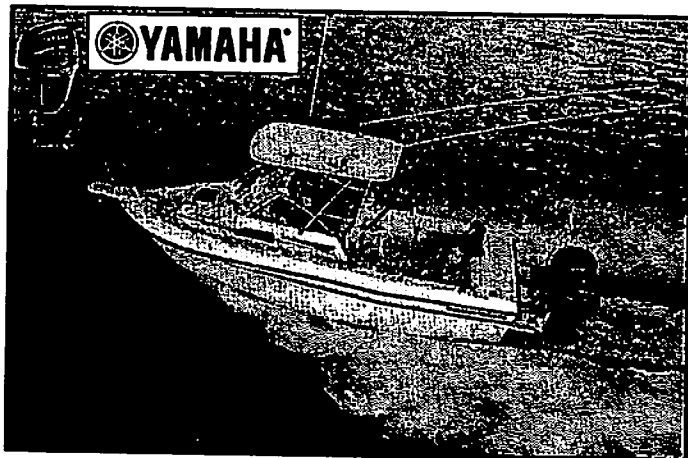

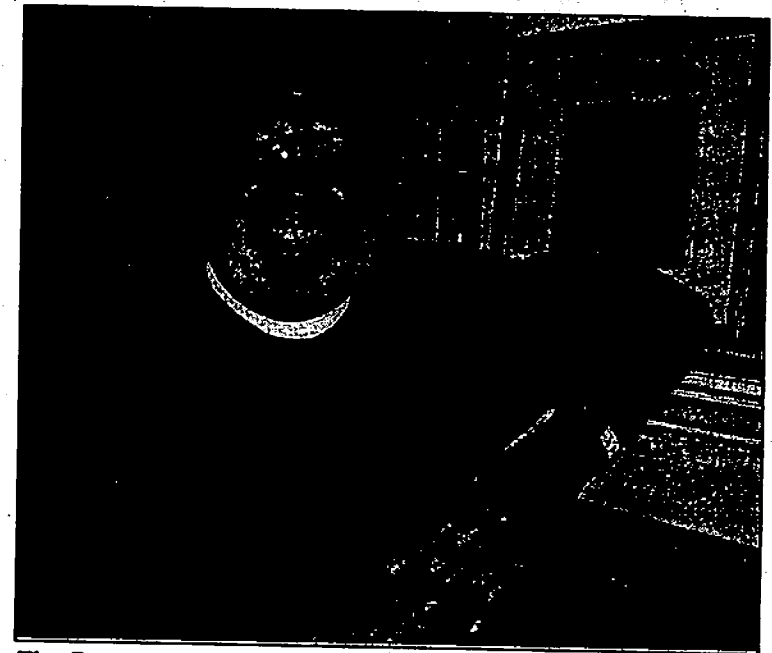


## St. John the Evangelist Appoints New Rector
