

Storm Causes Scattered Outages

Hundreds of Duxbury residents lost power during Friday's storm, with the first power outages reported at 3:50 pm and the last at 1 am on Saturday morning.

At 3:50 pm, a tree limb took out a power line on St. George Street, with witnesses reporting seeing the line sparking on the ground.

A total of 975 customers lost power, according to Mike Durand, NSTAR spokesman.

"275 customers had power back in 43 minutes, 515 had power restored in just over an hour, and 185 customers had power restored in 2 hours and 56 minutes," Durand said.

NSTAR tries to reroute any customer it can to another source to limit the duration of power outages, Durand said.

Two other fallen tree limbs caused outages in other parts of Duxbury throughout Friday night. A limb down on Tremont

Street left 460 customers without power for 27 minutes, and a limb down on Alden Street left 954 customers without power for an hour and a half, Durand said.

A blown fuse on Russell Road affected 30 customers for less than an hour.
