## Buses Set on Fire

Three buses housed at the Chandler School were vandalized sometime Friday Aug. 26.

Police Lt. Chip Chubb said plastic trash cans were placed on the buses and paper inside the barrels was set on fire. A seat on one of the buses was partially burnt and all of the trash cans melted. No one was hurt.

Mickey McGonagle, the schools' business manager,

said the company First Student owns the buses. All three have been replaced.

This is not the first time property at the Chandler School has been the target of vandalism. The Snack Shack at the Ray Coppens Field Complex adjacent to the school was broken into in mid August.

Lt. Chubb said the bus incident remains under investigation.
