Bay Circuit Trail Signs Installed

Roger Erickson and John Pechalonis, members of the Town's Open Space and Recreation Committee, recently installed the new Bay Circuit Trail signs at locations where the trail intersects Duxbury roads. Duxbury received a \$4,987 grant from the Department of Environmental Management for revitalization of its 7-mile section of the trail. Trailheads of this 200-mile path are Plum Island (Newburyport) and Bay Farm on the Duxbury-Kingston line.

The attractive signs were designed on a pro bono basis by Lans Bouthiller, of Lans Bouthiller Design Associates, Inc. Dick Rothschild, a member of the Open Space & Recreation Committee, supervised the design and production of the signs and John Joline, the Duxbury representative of the Bay Circuit Alliance, advised on and reviewed the sign locations. Assistance in the location and hole digging for the sign posts was offered by Wally Tonaszuck, Director of the DPW, and Peter Butkus, Superintendent of Lands & Natural Resources. Kudos to Pat Loring, Chairman of the Open Space Committee, for her oversight of the entire project.
