E. Virginia (Swift) Walker of Duxbury, formerly of Worcester, died peacefully at the age of 97 at Harbor House in Hingham. She was the beloved wife of the late Donald D. Walker, loving mother of Penelope Walker of Duxbury and Marcia B. Walker of Spraytown, Ind. and sister of the late Lincoln W. Smith.

Born in Worcester on July 17, 1917 she was the daughter of the late Stephen W. and Elsa (Ahlquist) Swift. A graduate of Worcester North High School, Mrs. Walker was active with the Red Cross as a nurse's aide during WWII.
