<u>Boat Name</u>	<u>Came ashore</u>	<u>Current Status</u>
"Yarmouth Clipper Ship"	Just North of Cape Hatteras Found by surfers	Presently in a Cape Hatteras school. Re-launch expected in early June.
"USS Millinocket"	Found by Turtle researchers in an uninhabited area near Georgetown, NC	Expected re-launch from research vessel out of Charleston, SC
"Charger"	Landed smack in the middle of Myrtle Beach, NC	Re-launched off Murtle Beach on June 2 nd and headed Northeast
"Sea Tiger:	Landed in an uninhabited bird sanctuary just north of Charleston, SC. No roads & extremely difficult place to recover. Capt. Stewart a Charleston pilot will attempt recovery.	Captain Stewart anchored his boat and had to swim ashore through rotted tree stumps to get "Charger". It's now at the Charleston Harbor Pilot Station
"SS Upper"	"Upper" landed on an extremely busy beach on Isle of Palms just a few miles north of Charleston, SC	Unfortunately we haven't heard a word about "Uppers" whereabouts but we have 2 people looking
