

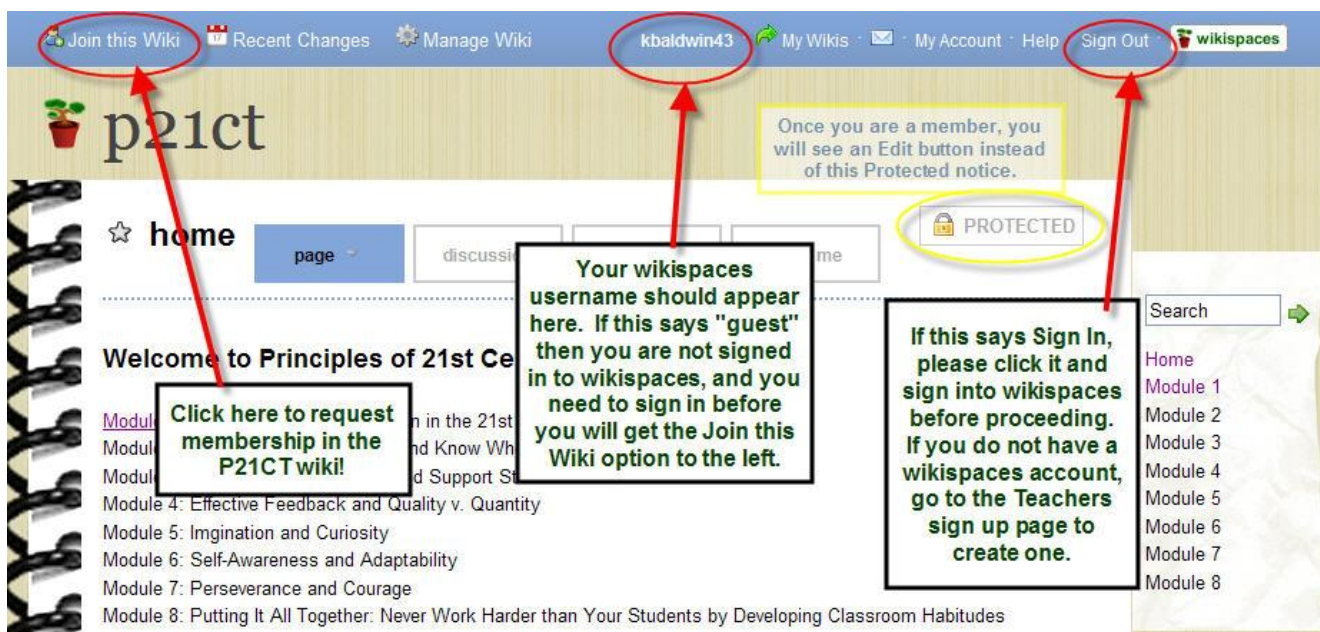
## How to Create a Voki

A voki is basically an animated character that you can have speak by either typing in the text, recording the information via microphone or telephone, or uploading an audio file.

\*Note: You will need to be a member of our wikispace in order to post your voki. If you have not yet joined the wiki, please do so before continuing with the Voki process.

### To join the P21CT wikispace

- If you do not already have a wikispaces account, please go to <http://www.wikispaces.com/site/for/teachers> and create an account. You do NOT need to create your own wiki at this time.
- If you already have a wikispaces account, please go to <http://p21ct.wikispaces.com/> and click Join this Wiki at the top left. You will get a dialog box that says "Request membership." Click that button and wait for the instructor to approve your request (if I'm online, I'll do it immediately).



### To record your text (optional)

- Use Audacity (free download), Garage Band, or another
- Open Audacity
- Ask for a microphone
- Click on the red button- this should start the recording
- Then click on file- export as Wav
- Save it on r drive- French - year 8 - 8x3 recording

## To create your Voki

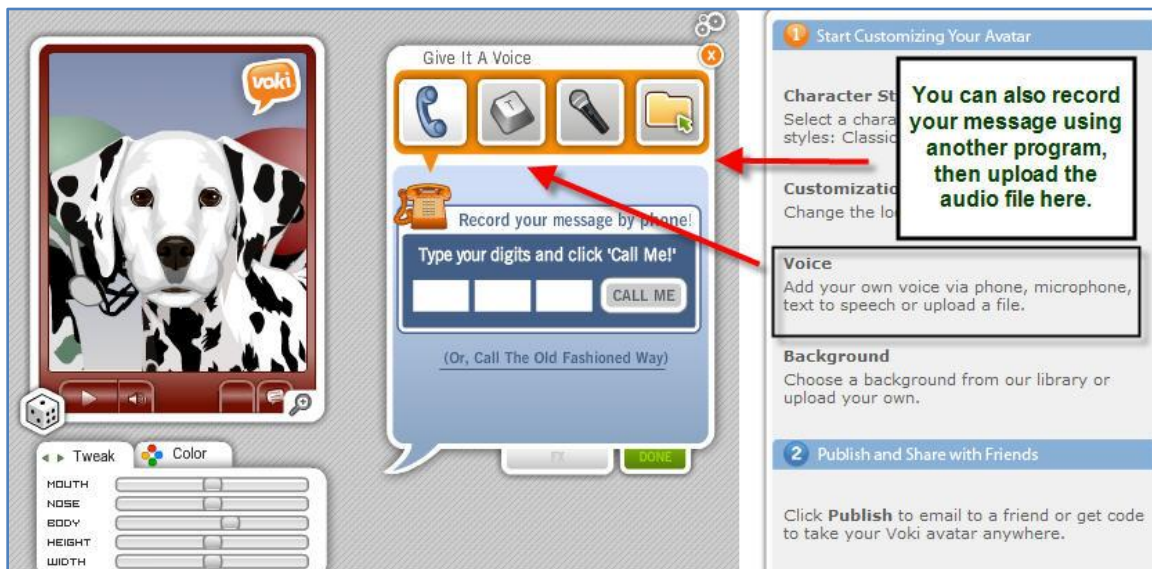
- Go to <http://www.voki.com/> and click on the Get Started button.
- Create a voki by clicking through the on-screen menus.



## Customize Your Character

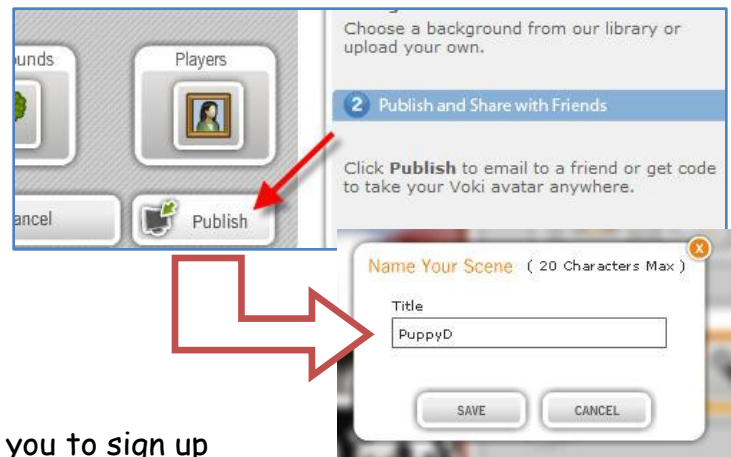


## Add Your Voice





- Click on Publish and name your scene (for example, Kris B.)



- Click "NO THANKS" when they ask you to sign up



- Highlight the code (the top one) and COPY it.

After you created your voki

- Then go to the P21CT wiki at <http://p21ct.wikispaces.com/Module1>
- Click Edit this page by the pencil in the top right.
- When the Editor toolbar opens, click in the table next to your name, then click on the TV icon in the toolbar.



- This will open up a list of widgets. Select the bottom one (Other) and you'll get a window where you can paste your code in. After you paste in the code, click Save, then click Save on the Editor toolbar and your Voki will be on the wiki!
