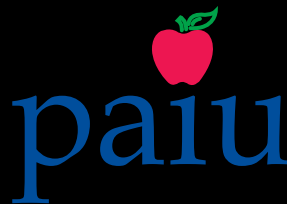

Engaging Students (7.5 Act 48 Hours)

The Engaging Students online course explores strategies for engaging students and promoting their active role in the classroom learning experience. The culminating activity for this course has participants collaborate on creating a lesson plan that uses active learning techniques. Themes in this course include: Engaging Questions, Teacher Strategies for Student Engagement, and Increasing Student Engagement.

The culminating activity for this course has participants "makeover" a lesson plan that elicits students' use of higher order thinking skills at Bloom's higher levels. Themes in this course include: Identifying Factual Data, Bloom's Taxonomy Review, and Thinking Skill Implementation Strategies.
