# Tech Summit III:

## ***South Western Instruction for the 21<sup>st</sup> Century Summit***

This summer's Tech Summit will focus on assessment, an integral part of quality instruction. The first day of the week-long summit will begin with a focus on developing a deeper understanding of quality assessment. We will then break out into cohorts based on technology skill level and at what level participants teach. These cohorts will rotate through one assessment topic per day during the remaining days of the Summit. Those topics include: Formative Assessments beyond "Ticket out the Door"; Project-based Assessments, Accessing & Analyzing our Data; and Building Quality Assessments. These daily sessions are taught by our own teachers and administrators and will build in time for collaboration and review. Join us as we sharpen our tech skills, discover new technologies and find ways to enhance assessment with technology!
