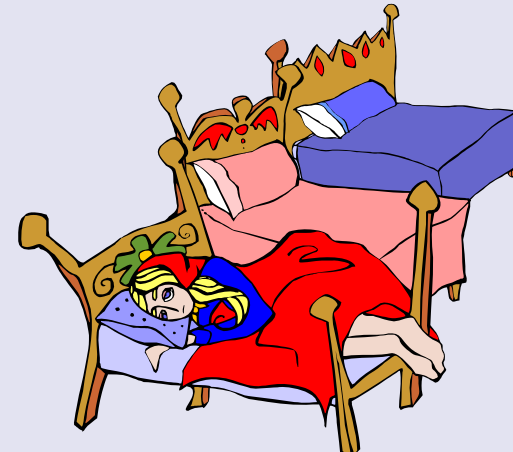


Computer Ethics - Moral Issues

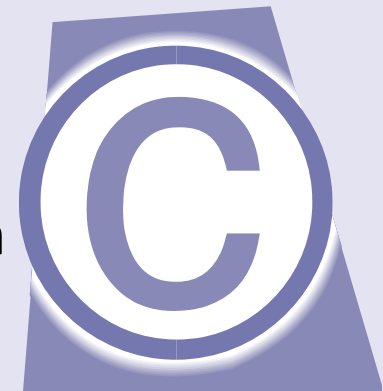
Computer Ethics - Copyright
