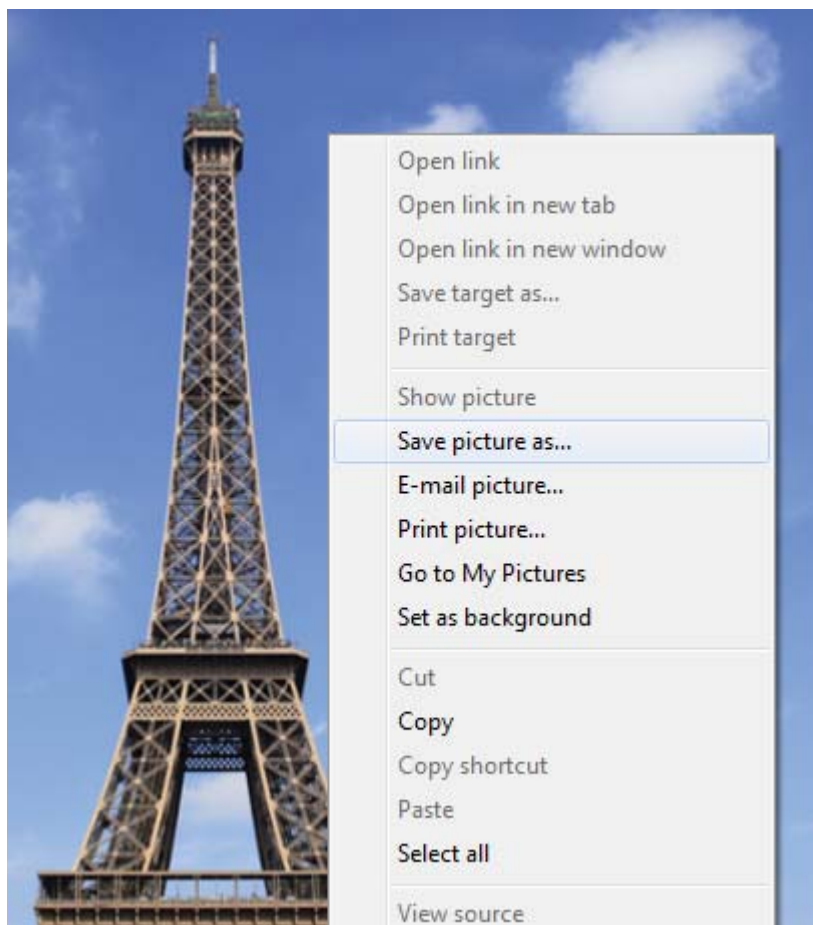
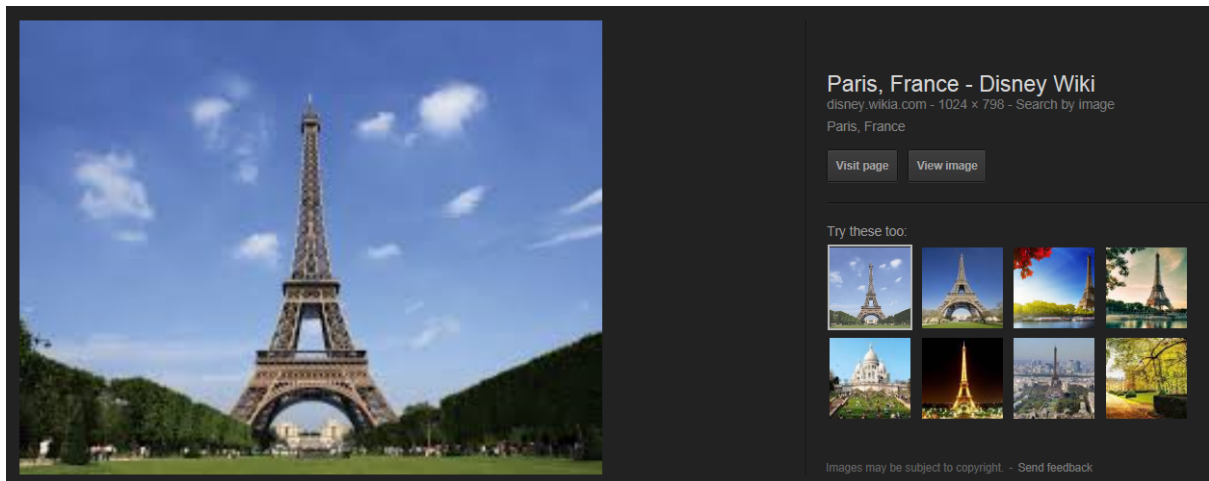


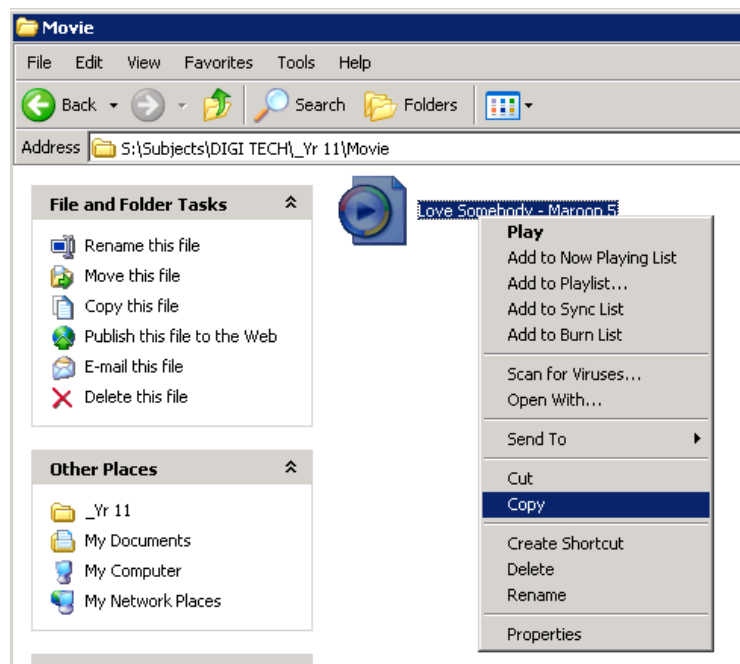
Movie Maker Tutorial:

Complete this practice task before you download and begin the assessment task.

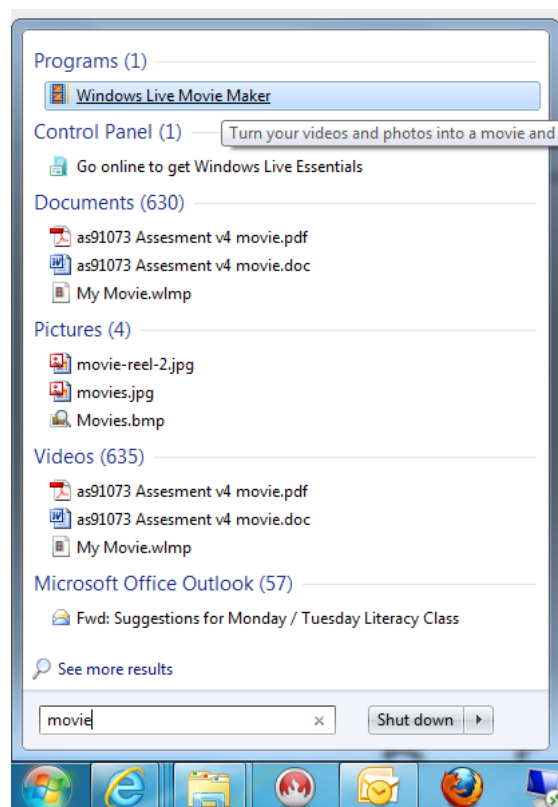
1. Google and save to your H drive 5 images of any country you would like to visit one day e.g. Paris; Australia; Rome; Japan – make sure you name each picture something meaningful so you know what it is. *Open Google Images; Search for your image; Click on View Image; Right click on it and choose Save Image/Picture As; Browse to your H drive and click Save*



- Open the Student Shared \ Digitech \ Year 11 \ Movie folder and copy the MP3 music file to your H drive.

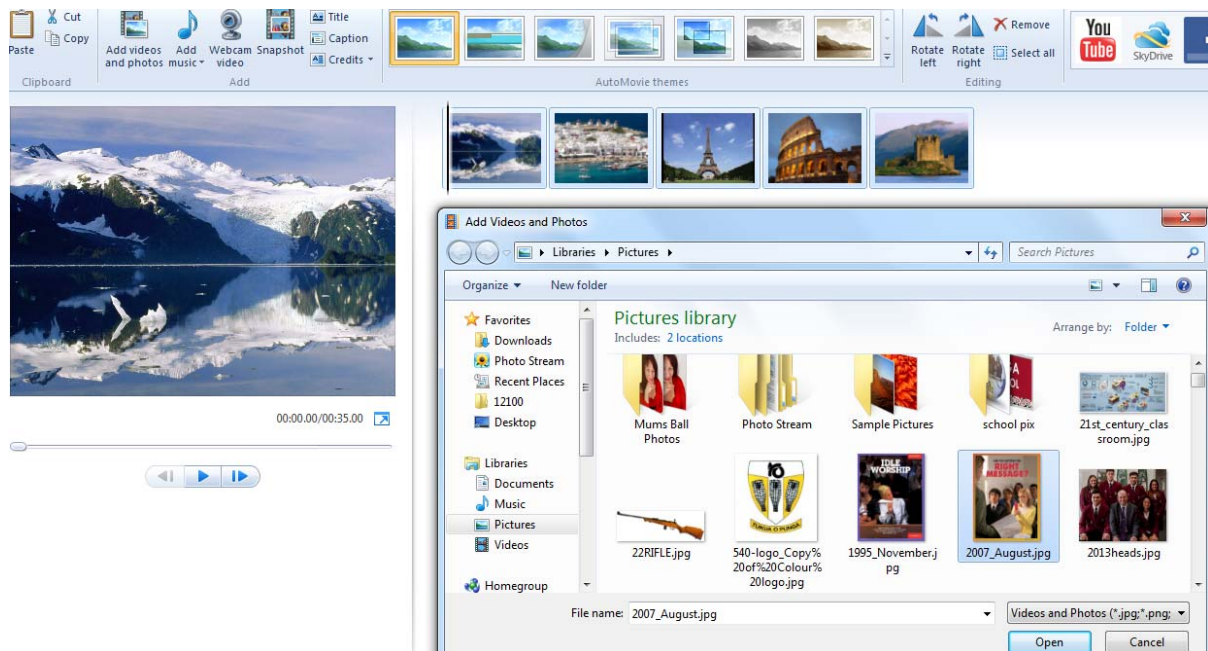


- Open Moviemaker – *click on Start and type Movie, then click on Movie maker*

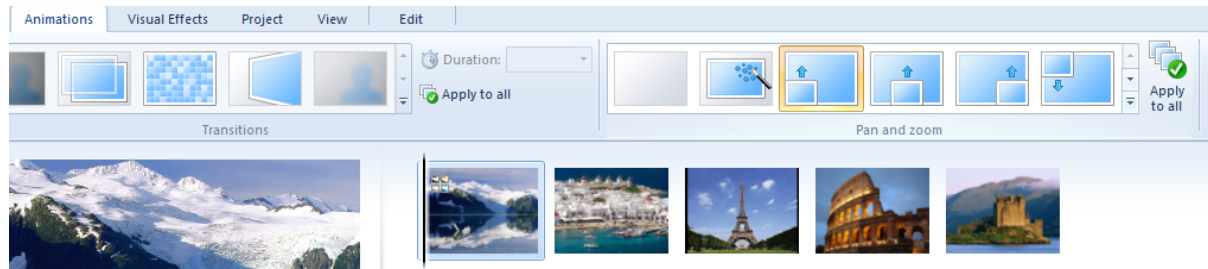


- Save your movie onto the H drive into the correct digital media folder. Call it Country.

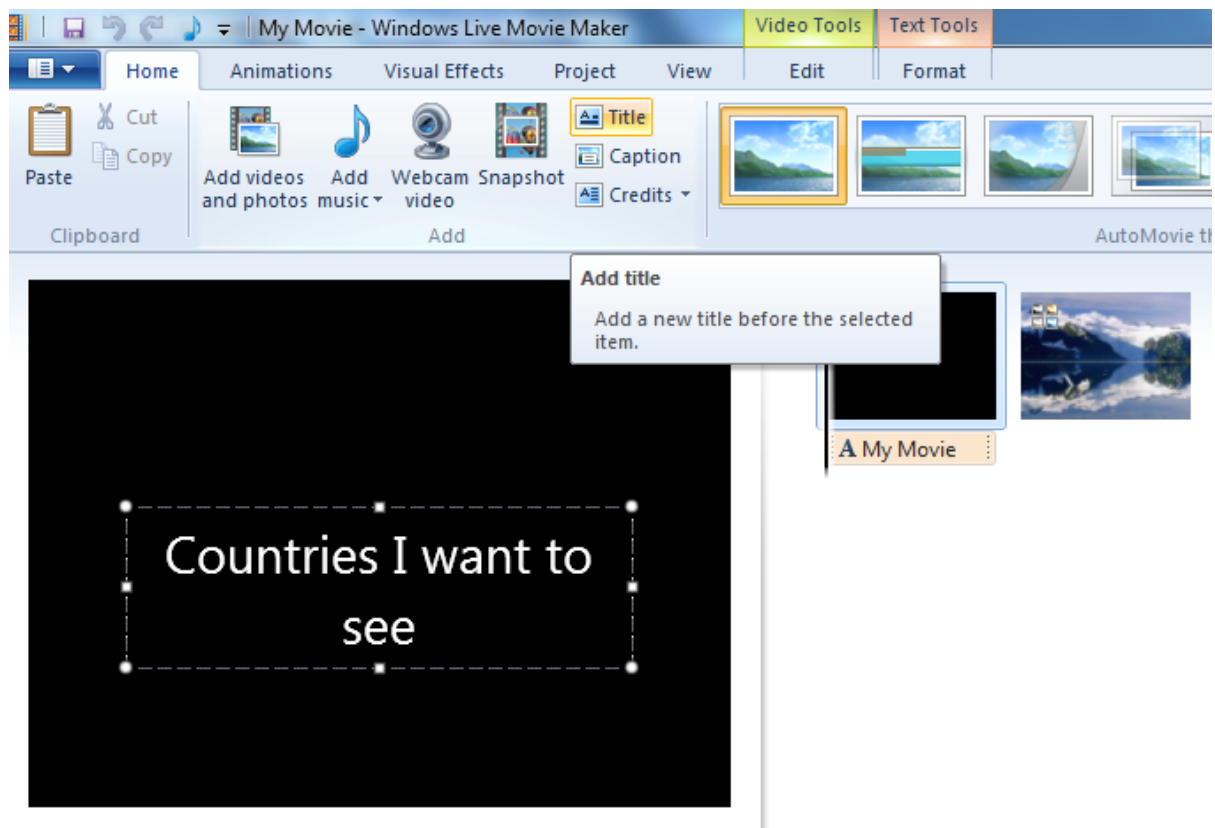
- Click on Add videos and Photos, browse to your H drive and add all 5 different countries to your movie. Click Open to insert the pictures. *You can multiple select by holding the Ctrl key and your mouse.*



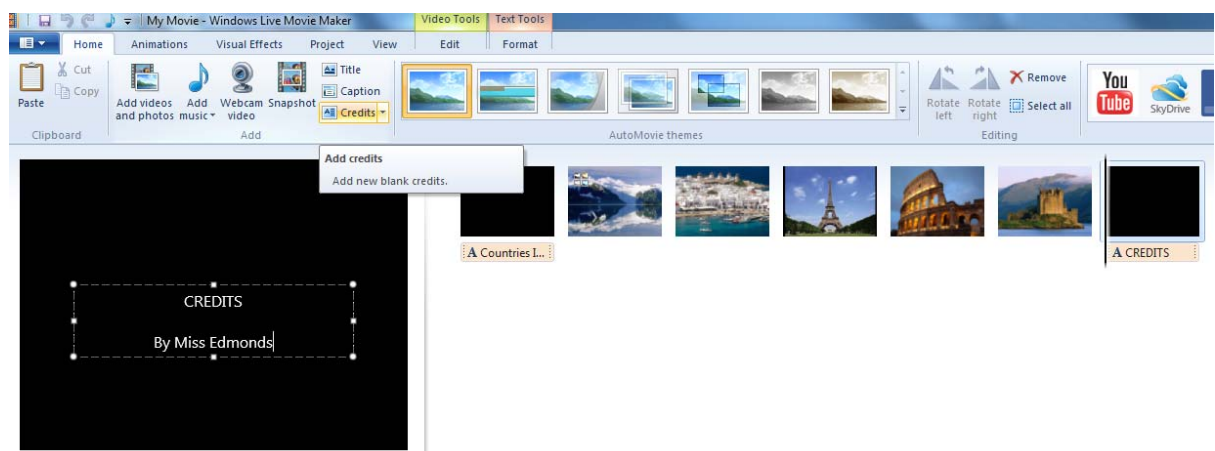
- Give every picture animation so it moves – *Click on the Animation tab. Under Pan and Zoom, for each picture choose animation you like.*



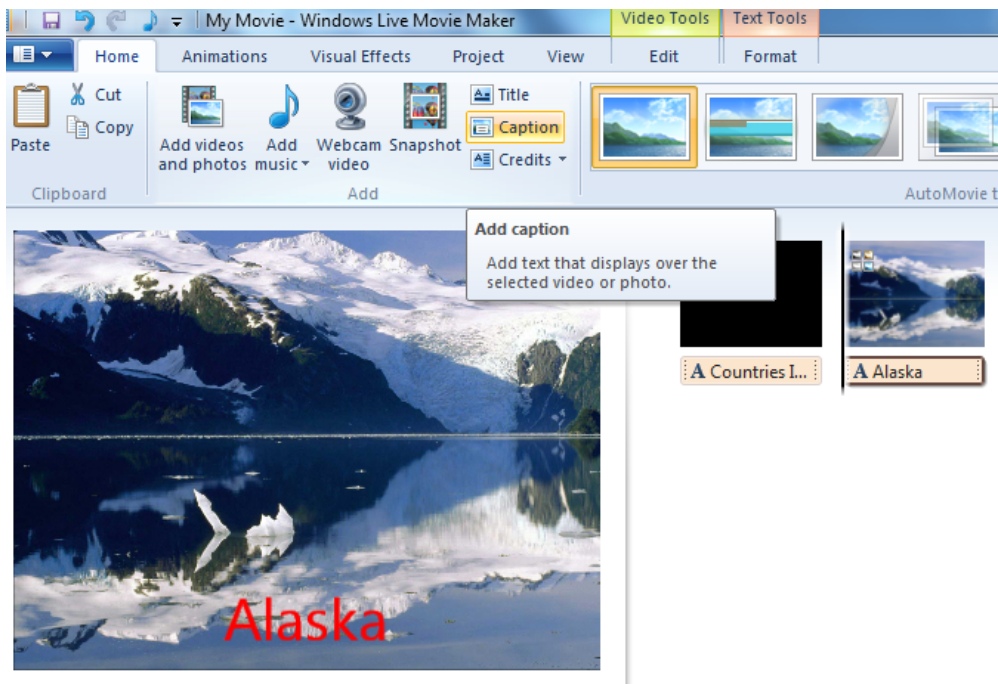
- Add a Title for your movie. Call it “Countries I want to see” – *Click on Home \ Title and type your text. Change colours and fonts.*



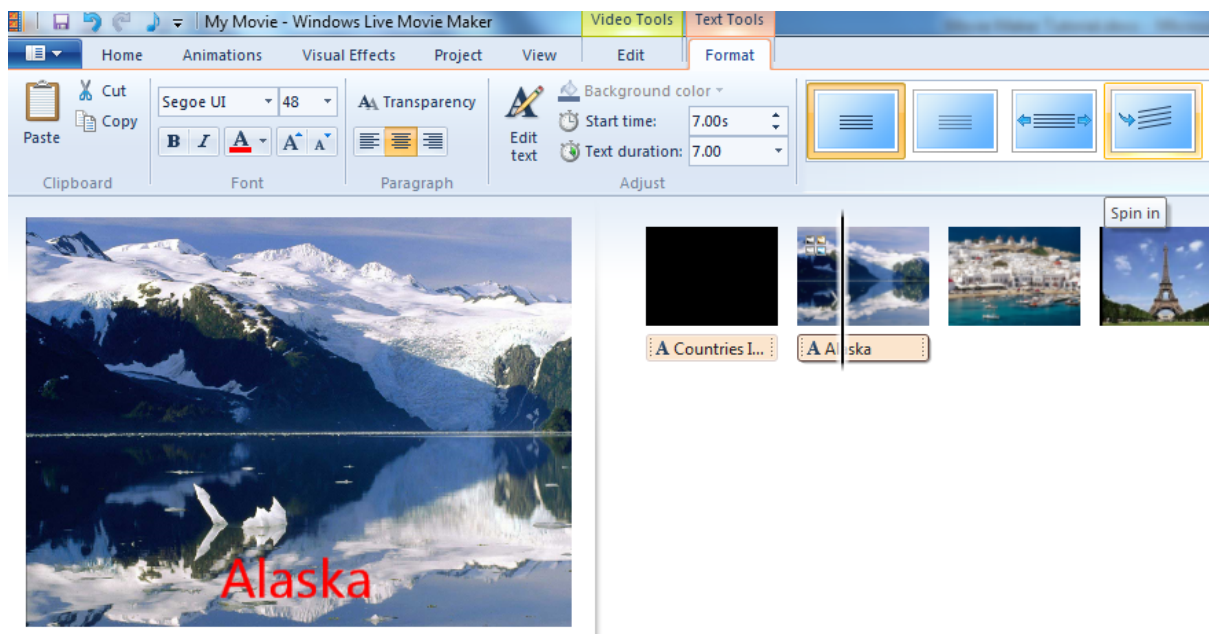
6. Add and Credit. Put your name – Click on Home \ Credits and then type your text.



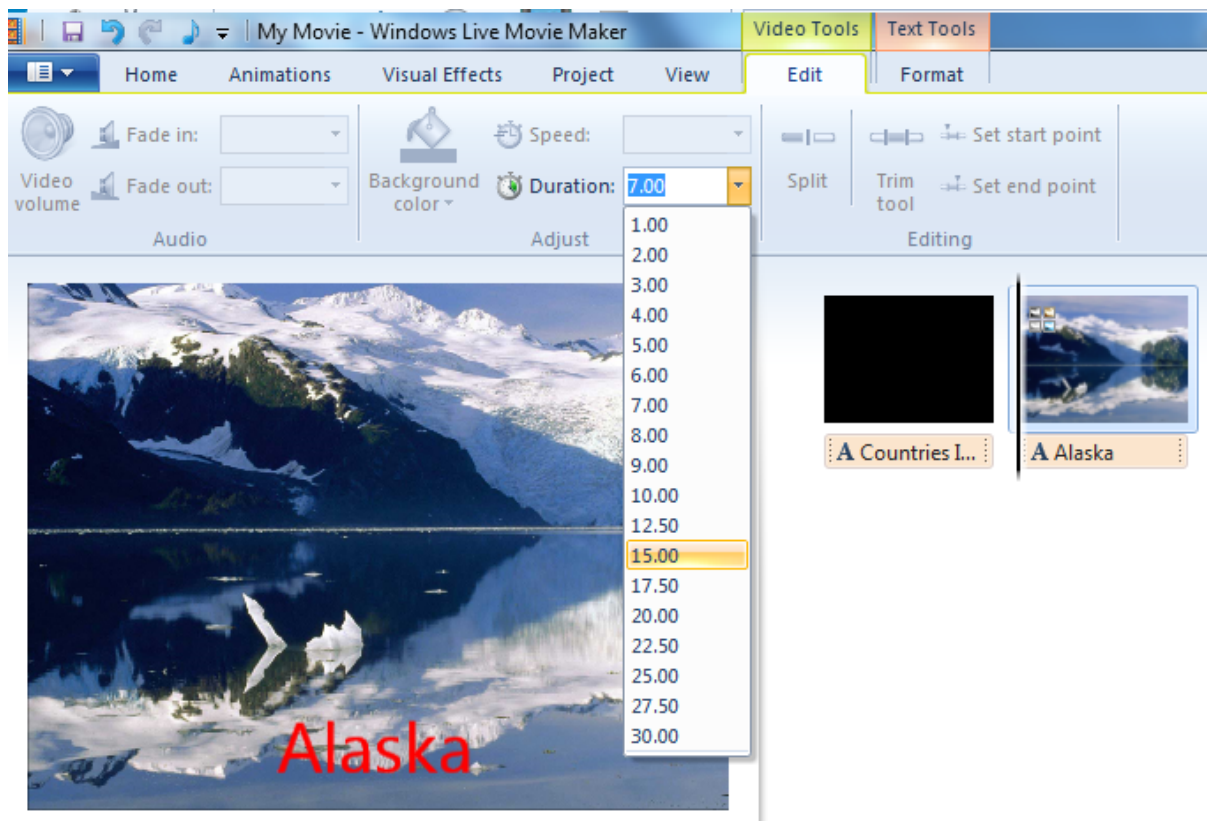
7. Add a caption over every picture that has the name of each country – select your picture; click Caption; Type your text;



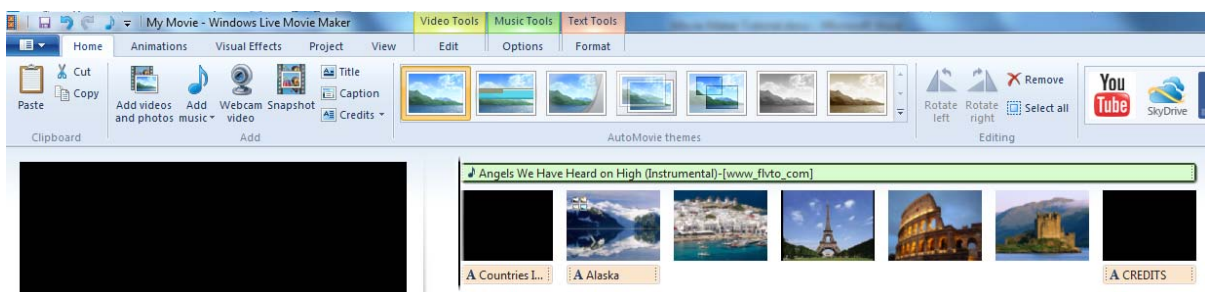
8. Make sure every caption has Text Effects – *Double click on the caption; Choose an effect you like – experiment with them.*



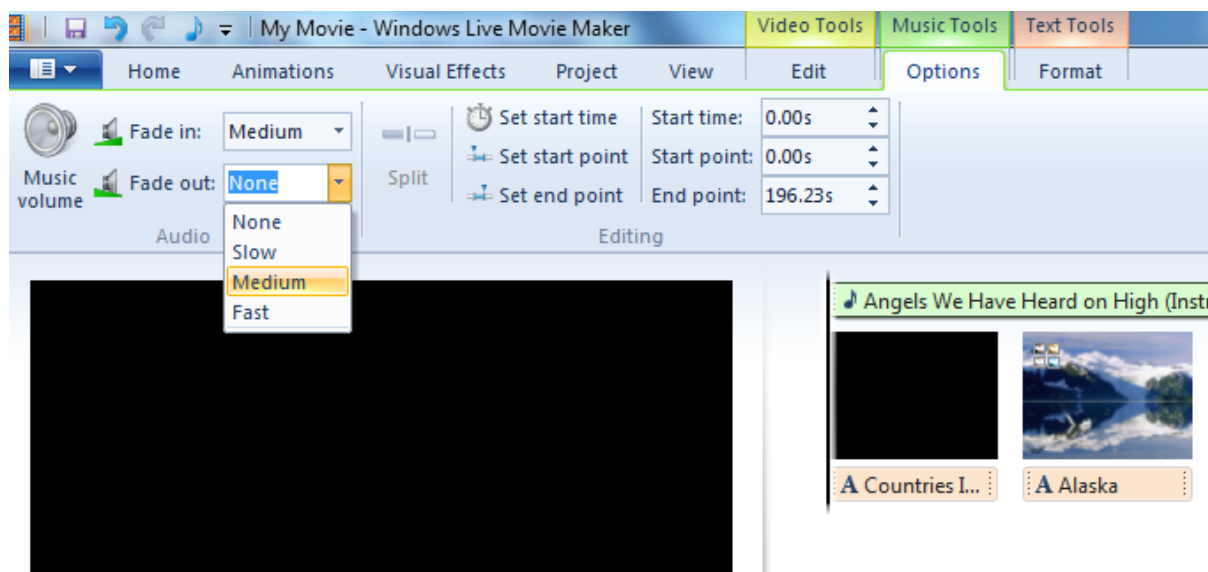
9. Increase the time your pictures play for to 15 seconds per country – *Double click on each picture and change the Duration drop down.*



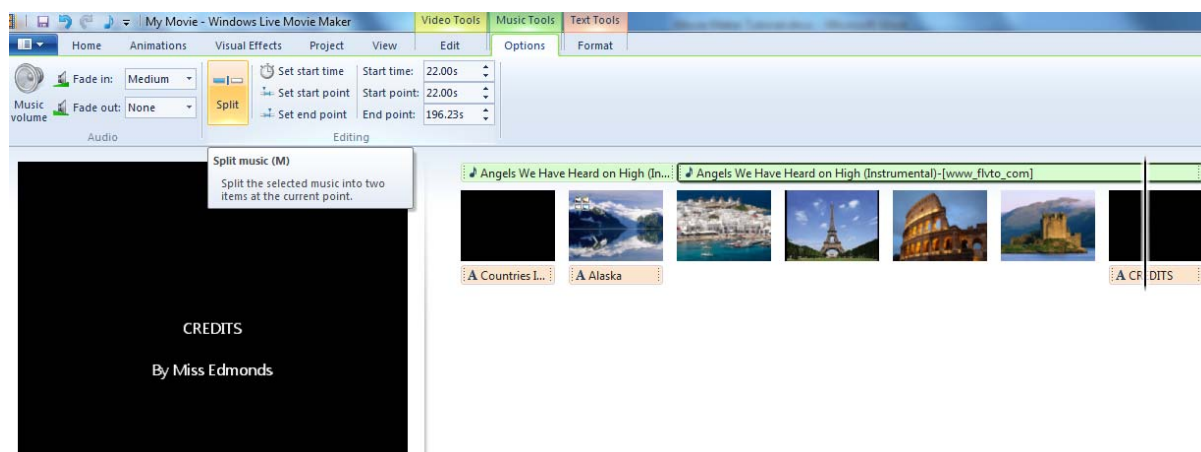
10. Add the audio file to your movie – click Home; Add Music; Add Music; Browse to your H drive and double click on the MP3 you copied from the above step. It will auto insert the music to begin at the start of your movie (note the green line)



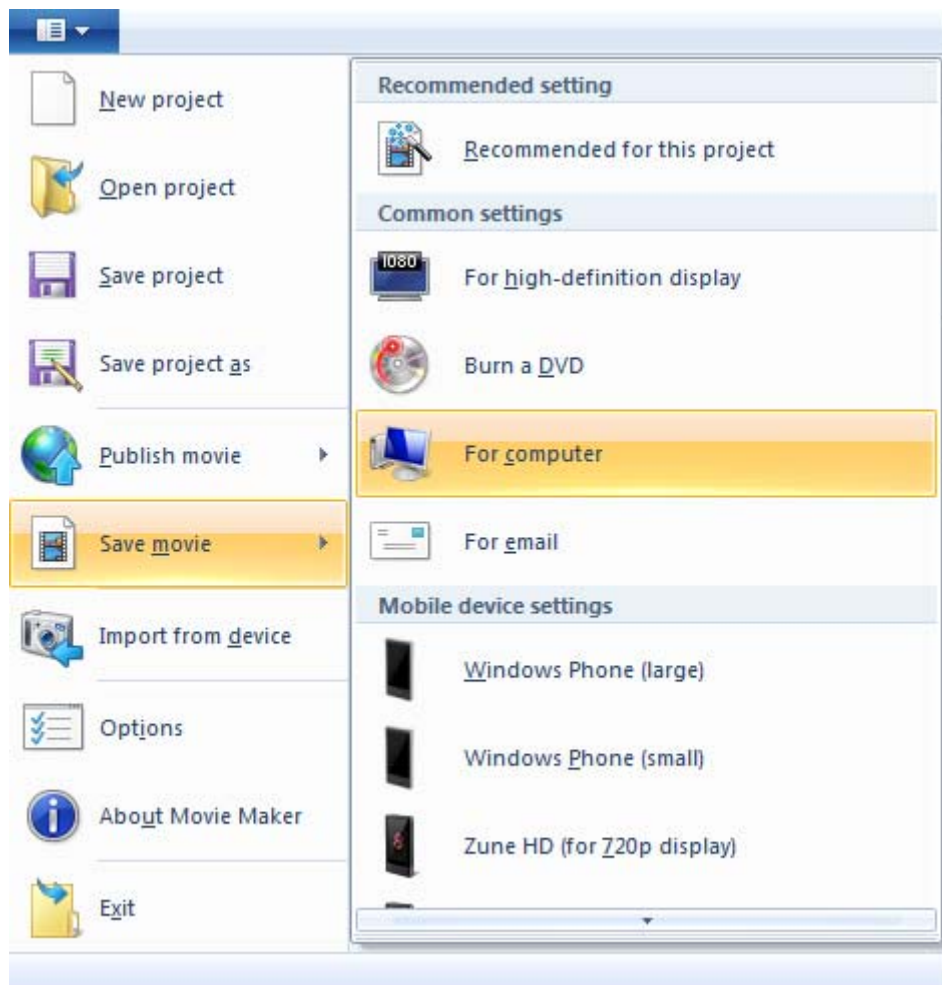
11. Make your music fade in and fade out so it doesn't sound "choppy" – double click on the green music line and choose the Fade In and Fade Out timing.



12. Split your audio file so it only plays on two of your countries. This process is identical if you wanted to edit a movie file also e.g. cut parts of an interview – *double click on the green music line; place the line where you want to split the music file; click split tool. You should now have two parts of the audio file.*



13. Save your movie again.
14. Export your movie to an MP4 file. This is an essential step for your assessment. You cannot just save your Movie Maker file. This is incomplete. You must export and give Miss the MP4 file. – *click on file; save movie; for computer; name the movie your name and country; click save;*



15. Show Miss your movie and then you can start the assessment on the Wiki.
