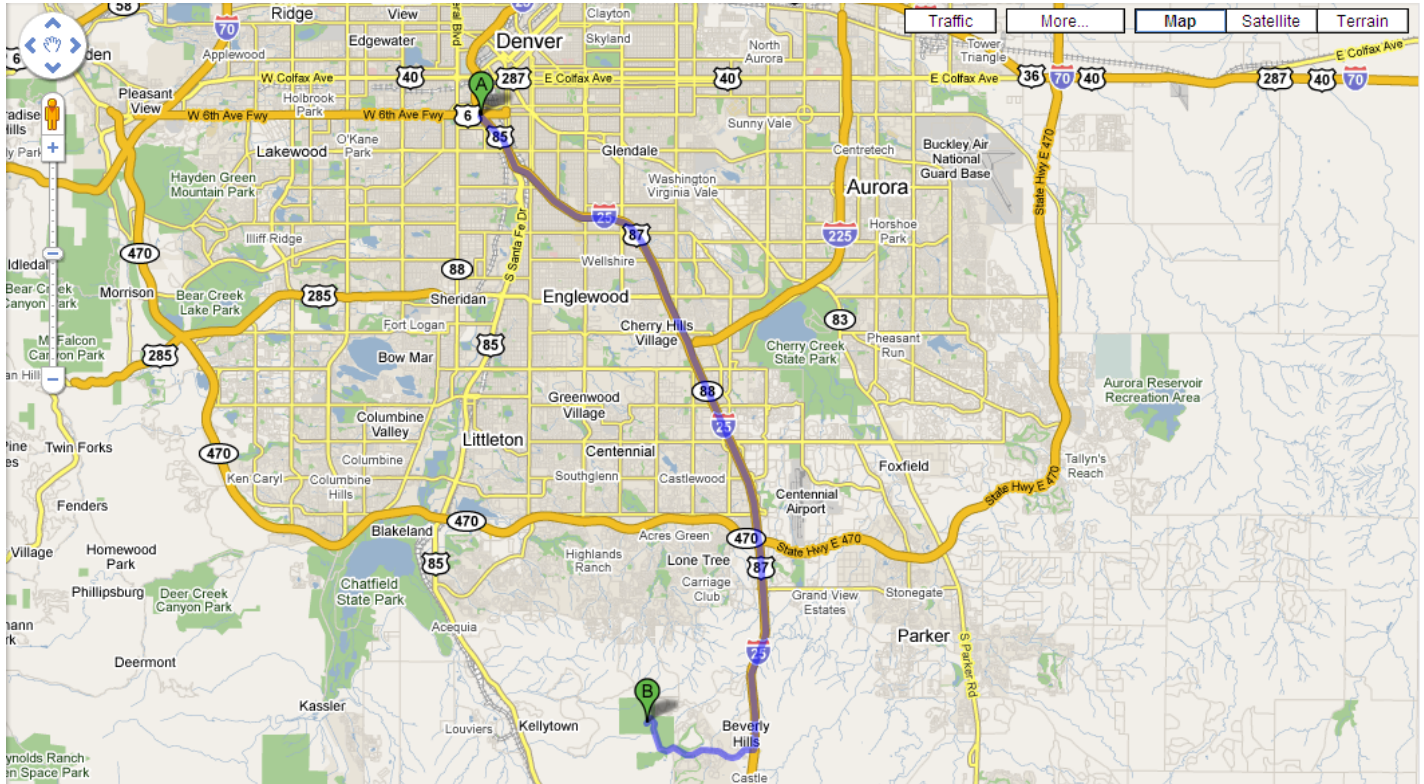

## Directions to Tall Bull Memorial Grounds



1. Heading **south** on I-25, exit at 188, Castle Pines Pkwy.
2. Keep **right** at the fork to continue toward **E Castle Pines Pkwy** and merge onto **E Castle Pines Pkwy**
3. Slight **left** at **Old Happy Canyon Rd**
4. Turn **right** at **N Daniels Park Rd**
5. **Continue north approximately 1 mile to Tall Bull entrance.**
