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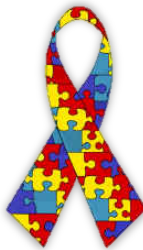

This app allows you to index & maintain a list of books with ease. This app is not an eBook Reader or a store browser. It is designed to help you sort through your books, find new books online, or create collections to share with others. Add books by using the iPhone's built-in camera, entering the ISBN numbers, or scanning the barcode. **(iPhone – free/\$3.99)**

### Endless Reader

A terrific app that expands the vocabulary of your students by using sight words, letter sounds, & animation to provide a fun way to help students remember the definition of a word. Monsters scatter the letters of the word, & then after the student drags them back into place, they have to fit the words into a full sentence with the monsters acting it out. **(free)**
