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clicker docs *(classroom skills)*

A friendly keyboard app with a built-in word prediction & recognizes phonetic spelling. It has text to speech & customized word banks. (iPad – \$28.99)



cookie next door – rainy days *(storytelling)*

Students become voice actors for the animated characters. They can record their voice & tell an story. (iPad – free)



enchanted dictionary 7-12th grade *(classroom skills)*

Learn vocabulary for core curricular areas. This app helps to focus on word definitions while students put the words in order. *Enchanted Dictionary 4-6th Grade* is also available. (iPad – \$1.99)



endless alphabet *(phonics)*

Build students vocabulary with monsters. Each word has a game putting the letters in order, sounds, & animation over the definition. (\$3.99)



little finder *(listening)*

Using text & audio, this hidden object game, helps little ones race to find the matching photo to build their vocabulary. (free)



phonics tic-tac-toe interactive game *(phonics)*

Exploring phonic sounds while playing the classic game tic-tac-toe. (free)



sentencebuilderteen *(grammar)*

Helps students learn how to build a grammatically correct sentence using themed images. (iPad – \$5.99)



toontastic *(storytelling)*

A great storytelling app where students can animate, draw & create their own cartoons. It allows students to create 5 scenes to follow a story arc & select music based on the mood of the scene. (iPad – free/\$19.99)



touch the sound *(listening)*

Using 4 pictures, students need to choose which image made the sound. (free)



videolicious *(creativity)*

Use this app for digital storytelling with your students. A simple photo/video-creator app where students can create narrated videos. Have students practice sequencing, articulation, & more. (free)



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
