Down For Everyone Or Just Me?



Here is a handy site that you will find yourself using on a regular basis, www.downforeveryoneorjustme.com, tells you if a website you're trying to go to is down or not. Just add the web address you're trying to visit. This site will then tell you if the site is up & it's just you or that the site is down. www.geoguessr.com is sort of a "where in the world" for the Google Maps generation. You are plunked down on a random patch of the globe, the middle of a city street, the barren desert, rolling countryside. You then have to figure out where you are by looking for clues around you, street signs, flora/fauna, etc. You can select timed or un-timed & you are assigned points based on how close your pinned guess is the actual location. Beyond the obvious use for geography students, this would be a great tool for a quick fiction writing exercise or pass-along story.

Kindle & Stop Motion Studio

If you have an Amazon account you will want to have the Kindle app for not only the iPhone/iPod & the iPad, but also for your laptop & Droid devices. The Kindle app is a great e-reader for all the books available through Amazon. You don't need a Kindle to use the app. All your books will be kept on the cloud & all your books are available on multiple devices at the same time. **(free)**



Create easy stop motion movies for free! Simply load in your photo images & this app strings them together in to stop-motion. You can add a recording of your own voice narration or music from your iTunes Library.

This is good practice for step-by-step planning & visualizing what you want the final product to look like. This would be great for a book trailer teaser, & introduction to a presentation, illustrating science labs, a visual character summary, etc. **(free/\$4.99)**
