(speech & language therapy)

Does exactly what it says it does. Also includes great videos that model ASL signs.



AVOKIDDO EMOTIONS – \$2.99
(life skills)

Teach kids about emotions with helping them learn how to read expressions & body language. Three animal characters do this with lots of props. Dress them up & watch their reaction.



CONVERSATION SOCIAL STORIES & PECS COMMUNICATION TOOL – \$3.99
(life skills)

This app helps show your student how to have a conversation based on where they are & what they are trying to do.



CUT THE BUTTONS – \$0.99/\$1.99
(fine motor skills)

Great for fine motor development, does not mirror a typical scissor hold but must use two fingers to "cut" buttons off pockets as they are moving around on the screen.



DIALSAFE PRO – FREE
(life skills)

Helps children learn how to dial important numbers, like 911 & other numbers added by parents.



IF... – iPad – free
(game)

A role-playing game that practices social & emotional learning by interacting with characters, rebuilding Greenberry, & saving & collecting the Zim.



MODEL ME GOING PLACES 2 – free
(life skills)

An app that builds social skills with 6 sets of narrated photos that demonstrate appropriate & expected behaviors at different locations.



MY VIDEO SCHEDULE – iPhone – \$4.99
(life skills)

100+ photos & videos with step-by-step instructions for scheduled activities & behaviors. You can also add a photo or video of your own to supplement the library.



PETTING ZOO – ANIMAL ANIMATIONS
– \$2.99 (game)

Play with 21 animals & see what they do when you tap them. Musical sounds & funny animations are used for each animal. (Ex – Can a dog breakdance? What would an elephant do in your bathroom?)



SLOWTUNES – iPhone – \$1.99
(music)

A music player that lets you slow down the song without changing the pitch. Helps children keep up with their favorite song & to sing along at their pace.
