<p>“Pyramid Write” your spelling words. You must write neatly!</p> <p>Ex. h he hea hear</p>	<p>Type “Em: Type your words on the computer. Make each word have a different font. Then print it out.</p>	<p>Across and Down Words: Write each of your spelling words across and down.</p> <p>Ex. hear e a r</p>
<p>Write your spelling words in alphabetical order.</p>	<p>Write your spelling words on cards (make 2 sets) and play “Memory Match” with them against a sibling or a parent.</p>	<p>Make and complete a word search using www.puzzlemaker.com</p>
<p>Write each spelling word three times.</p>	<p>Write a mnemonic sentence to help you remember each of your spelling words. Each letter of the word should start a word in the sentence. For example, a mnemonic sentence for the word throw might be Ted has rented one wheelbarrow.</p>	<p>Choo-Choo Words: Write the entire list end-to-end as one long word. Use different colored crayon for each word.</p> <p>Ex. sleeprainyearbeard</p>
