Spelling Tic-Tac-Toe

This board includes many different activities to help your child practice his/her spelling words. Your child must choose at least three of the activities to complete for weekly homework. The activities must make a tic-tac-toe line: horizontal, vertical, or diagonal three in a row. Please mark your choices with crayon, marker, etc. Parents, you are encouraged to assist your child as needed to make homework a positive learning experience. Make a set of flashcards on index cards to study your words.	"Pyramid Write" your spelling words. You must write neatly! Ex. h he hea hear	Write each spelling word three times.
Have an adult give you a practice test at home. Be sure the test is checked and signed by an adult.	Put all spelling words in alphabetical order.	Write each word once making the word parts (<i>over-</i> , <i>under-</i> , <i>sub-</i>) red and the rest of the word blue.
Write each spelling word in a rainbow of colors. First write the words with a red crayon, Trace over the words with a blue crayon. Finally, trace the words again with a green crayon.	Make and complete a word search using www.puzzlemaker.com	Write a sentence for 20 of the words
