Spelling Tic-Tac-Toe

This board includes many different activities to help your child practice his/her spelling words. Your child must choose at least three of the activities to complete for weekly homework. The activities must make a tic-tac-toe line: horizontal, vertical, or diagonal three in a row. Please mark your choices with crayon, marker, etc. Parents, you are encouraged to assist your child as needed to make homework a positive learning experience. Spelling Math: Which spelling word has the highest value? Which word has the lowest value? Do any words have an equal value? (Use the secret code to find a numeric value for each letter.)	Write each spelling word three times.	Write your spelling words in crayon or pen. Write each consonant letter in red and each vowel in blue.
Write your spelling words in alphabetical order.	Write your spelling words on cards (make 2 sets) and play "Memory Match" with them against a sibling or parent.	Make and complete a word search using www.puzzlemaker.com
Write a song or a rap using all of your spelling words.	Write a letter to a friend/relative, in proper letter format, using at least 15 of the spelling words. Underline each word.	Write a mnemonic sentence to help you remember each of your spelling words. Each letter of the word should start a word in the sentence. For example, a mnemonic sentence for the word <i>throw</i> might be <u>T</u> ed <u>h</u> as <u>r</u> ented <u>o</u> ne <u>w</u> heelbarrow.
