

**ORDER FOR TEMPORARY CUSTODY, PARENTING TIME  
AND RELATED MATTERS**

At a session of the Court held at the Courthouse  
in the City Saginaw, County of Saginaw, Michigan  
on October 10, 2012.

PRESENT: HONORABLE FRED L. BORCHARD, CIRCUIT JUDGE

The parties appeared personally and by counsel at the time set for hearing on Defendant's Motion for Summary Disposition re: Jurisdiction of the Court. The Court determined it had Jurisdiction to enter a temporary order to govern the parties pending further proceedings on the Motion in Michigan and further proceedings in the State of Maryland. Pursuant to the agreement of the parties' and findings of the court;

IT IS ORDERED:

1. The children, Rocco Jefferson Calice d/o/b 10/27/2006 and Amelia Jayne Calice, d/o/b 04/25/2008, shall be in the principal care of and reside with Plaintiff –Mother in the State of Michigan until further order of the court.
2. The parties shall exercise joint legal custody under MCL 722.26a (7) (b)-share decision making authority as to important decisions affecting the welfare of the child. During the time the child resides with a parent, that parent shall decide all routine matters concerning the child. (See, Saginaw County Friend of the Court Parenting Requirements, May 2010 version).
3. Defendant –father shall have the right to exercise parenting time:
  - a) from Tuesday, October 9, 2012 after school until Tuesday, October 23, 2012.
  - b) on alternate weekends commencing November 10, 2012. Weekends are defined for purposes of this Order as beginning at 5pm on Friday and return the children to school on Monday morning.
  - c) For the 2012 Thanksgiving Holiday from November 21, 2012 at 4pm until 3 pm the day before school resumes.
  - d) For the 2012 Christmas Holiday from Christmas Day at 3 pm until January 1, 2013 at 3 pm.
  - e) The exercise of parenting time shall not interfere with Rocco’s attendance at school (7:40 am to 2:40 pm).
4. Except for the Holiday parenting time provided in ¶’s 3 c) and d); Defendant Father shall not remove the children from the State of Michigan.
5. Each parent shall have the ability to have reasonable contact with the children by FaceTime (or other internet based audio visual communication medium) while they are in the care of the other parent. Reasonable contact means once per day for approximately 8 to 12 minutes and such other times as the children (or either of them) expresses a desire to communicate directly with the other parent.
6. Neither parent shall discuss with the children, or allow others to do so, the merits of the respective parties positions in the pending litigation in Michigan or Maryland, the evidence that may be offered in the litigation or any other matter related to the litigation.

7. Neither parent shall make, or allow others to do so, disparaging remarks about the other parent or the conduct of the other parent.

8. Counsel shall facilitate, with the assistance of Maryland counsel, the communication between this Court and Court in the State of Maryland in which proceedings between the parties is pending as contemplated by § 110 of the UCCJEA, MCL 722.1110. Counsel shall have the right to be present and present such information as may be requested by the Judge of either Court.

9. This is a Temporary Order subject to further proceedings on Defendant's motion for summary disposition or modification upon proper motion and hearing.




