



Mid-Michigan schools close Monday, Jan. 6; MBS airport cancels, delays flights as snow storm hits

As a winter storm pelts Michigan with up to 14 inches of snow, mid-Michigan schools are starting to call off classes on Monday, Jan. 6.

Saginaw School District, Birch Run School District, Swan Valley School District, Saginaw Township Community Schools, Frankenmuth School District, Chesaning Union School District, Merrill Community Schools and Reese Public Schools won't open Monday, among others.

Bay City Public Schools, Bangor Township Schools and **Delta College** are closed in Bay County. Midland Public Schools also are **closed**.

Many districts throughout the Thumb and south in Genesee County also are closed Monday.

Saginaw Valley State University is **closed**, although the winter semester does not start until Jan. 13.

MBS International Airport **canceled three flights** on Sunday, one arrival from Detroit and one from Chicago's O'Hare International Airport, along with one departure to O'Hare. Other flights are delayed.

The winter storm will bring the **coldest temperatures** Michigan has had in two decades on Monday and Tuesday, with the wind chill nearing -40 degrees. The National Weather Service issued a **winter weather advisory** for Saginaw, Bay and Midland counties.

The storm has caused other businesses to close early, such as **Birch Run Premium Outlets**.
