Rising action/event #1 stated and explained			
Details given that explain the event and lead to the next event			
Rising action/event #2 stated and explained			
Details given that explain the event and lead to the next event			
Rising action/event #3 stated and explained			
Details given that explain the event and lead to the climax/additional events			

<b><u>Climax (Additional Details)</u></b>			
Events from the rising action lead to the climax/end of the event if nonfiction			
Climax of the story is revealed/conclusion of event if nonfiction			
Specific details are given to explain the climax of the story/end of the event			

<b><u>Conclusion of Book Project</u></b>			
Main idea is restated or revisited			
Leaves the reader with something to think about or a lasting impression			

<b><u>Writing/Audio/Video</u></b>			
Variety in word choice, images, and video			
Variety in sentence structure, clearly stated and easy to understand			
Details (and pictures if applicable) relate to each other to retell the story.			
Transitions/introductory words are used to relate paragraphs/ideas			
Final draft form- grammar, spelling, punctuation, error-free
