

Le Passé composé – Auxiliaire Être

Être = **to be** (Translate)

(in the **present** tense)

Pronoun	To be	Pronom	être
I	am	Je	suis
You	are	Tu	es
He	is	il	est
She	is	elle	est
One	is	on	est
We	are	nous	sommes
You (pl.)	are	vous	êtes
They (masc.)	are	ils	sont
They (fém.)	are	elles	sont

What are the four golden questions?

1. Is the pronoun **DEFINITELY** a **girl**?
2. Is the pronoun **POSSIBLY** a **girl**?
3. Is the pronoun **DEFINITELY** more than **one person**?
4. Is the pronoun **POSSIBLY** more than **one person**?

Fill out the table by putting the appropriate **accord** that fits with the pronoun. Make sure to ask yourself the four golden questions.

Pronoun	Accord	Reasoning
je	(e)	“je” is POTENTIALLY a girl.
tu	(e)	“tu” is POTENTIALLY a girl.
il	-	The answer is NO to all 4 golden questions.
elle	e	“elle” is DEFINITELY a girl.
on	(e)	“on” is POTENTIALLY a girl.
nous	(e)s	“nous” is POTENTIALLY a girl and DEFINITELY plural.
vous	(e)(s)	“vous” is POTENTIALLY a girl and POTENTIALLY plural.
ils	s	“ils” is DEFINITELY plural.
elles	es	“elles” is DEFINITELY a girl and DEFINITELY plural.
