

## Tâche 1 – Mon casse-croûte

You will open up a new casse-croûte (snack bar) for your school. Prepare a presentation, on PowerPoint or on a Bristol board, to show your class your new and unique concept. To help come up with ideas for your restaurant, you can use your textbook and cahier. [Names, slogans, dishes (les mets) cost, portions etc.]

### Your presentation should include:

- Le nom du casse-croûte. (Name)
- Pourquoi tu penses que c'est un concept gagnant. (Why is your restaurant a good idea)
- Un slogan
- Le menu et les prix (menu and prices)
- Un repas économique (a special meal deal and or combos)

### Grammar Criteria

Over the course of your presentation, you must include the following language structures (in these colours):

- 2 **-er** verbs in the present tense
  - 2 **-ir** verbs in the present tense
  - 2 **-re** verb in the present tense
  - 2 **-oir** verbs in the present tense
  - 2 **irregular** verbs in the present tense
