Russia estimates amounts of fish in Senegalese waters

A Russian scientific expedition, for the first time in the last 20 years, has examined the fish resources in Senegal's economic zone.

On Saturday, Russian ship "Atlantida" with 11 Russian and 3 Senegalese scientists on board entered the Senegalese port of Dakar for summing up the results of their mutual investigation.

The scientists have held the hydroacoustic evaluation of the amount of various kinds of fish in the region – the Western African horse-mackerel, sardinella, scomber and others. The amounts turned out to be large.

This expedition is very important for Russia, because Senegal's sea zone is an area where Russia has been fishing for many years.
