COOPERATION IN THE FIELD OF FISHERIES

AGREEMENT

RUSSIAN GOVERNMENT

May 20, 2010

(L)

The Government of the Russian Federation and the Government of the Republic of Namibia, hereinafter referred to as the Parties,
based on the mutual desire to strengthen friendly relations and cooperation among States Parties in conservation and management of living marine resources, and their management,

Realizing that cooperation in the field of fisheries on mutually beneficial terms will contribute to the development of the fishing industry States Parties

Taking into account the United Nations Convention on Law of the Sea of 10 December 1982, and recognizing the sovereign rights of States Parties in the field of research, and conservation living marine resources and their management within exclusive economic zones of States Parties

Have agreed as follows:

Article 1

The purpose of this Agreement is to promote cooperation in fisheries on a mutually beneficial and equitable basis in accordance with the laws of the Parties.

Article 2

The Parties shall promote cooperation in the following directions:

- conservation, monitoring and management of living marine resources;
- prevention, control and eradication of illegal, unreported and unregulated fishing of marine living resources;
- exchange of information and documentation relating to the fishery;
- conduct fisheries research and development scientific and technical programs;
- aquaculture and mariculture by adapting new fisheries species and increase the rate of production of species artificially grown at the present time;

training and skills development for the fishing industry,
the direction of experts to exchange experiences;
development and implementation of joint projects on marine fisheries
fishing, processing and marketing of fish products;
development of mining and processing technologies, including the quality and
safety of seafood products;
development of related species fisheries production
activities, in particular, shipbuilding, ship repair, construction
freezers, cold storage and processing facilities;
the use by Russian vessels on commercial terms
Namibian port for repairs, maintenance,
procurement, replenishment of food, replacement crews, as well as in
other purposes related to fisheries and research
activities;
for bilateral symposia, seminars, consultations,
the direction of experts to exchange experiences in the field of fish
the economy;
the development of other fisheries cooperation
of mutual interest.

Article 3

1. In order to ensure compliance with the provisions of this Agreement
The Parties shall establish a Joint Russian-Namibian Fisheries Commission
Officer (hereinafter - the Joint Committee on Fisheries)
coordinating and ensuring the implementation of cooperation, the
referred to in Article 2.

2. Each Party shall appoint a Joint Committee on Fisheries
economy of its representative and his deputy, and shall inform the
the other Party through diplomatic channels.

3. Each Party shall bear the costs of participation of its delegation to the
meetings of the Joint Committee on Fisheries.

4. Meetings of the Joint Committee on Fisheries held
alternately in the territory of each Party not less than 1 time per
year.

5. The results of the discussions of the Joint Committee on Fisheries
documented in minutes.

6. At the first session of the Joint Committee on Fisheries
adopt its own rules of procedure.

Article 4

The parties have the right to open representative offices,
supervising fisheries in the Republic of Namibia and
territory of the Russian Federation on terms to be agreed
between the Parties.

Article 5

1. In the event of a dispute between the Parties concerning
the interpretation and application of the provisions of this Agreement or
agreements and additional protocols allow these parties
disputes through consultations through diplomatic channels.

2. Consultations shall be held immediately at the request of
Parties.

Article 6

Nothing in this Agreement shall be construed as
prejudicing the rights and obligations of each of the Parties under other
international treaties.

Article 7

1. This Agreement is valid for 5 years and takes
effect from the date of receipt of the last written notification that the
Parties of internal procedures necessary for its
entry into force.

This Agreement shall be automatically extended for
subsequent five-year periods, unless either Party notifies in
writing through diplomatic channels to the other of its
intention to terminate the Agreement. Term of Agreement
expires 12 months after receipt of the notice of intent
terminate the Agreement.

2. Termination of this Agreement shall not affect the rights
