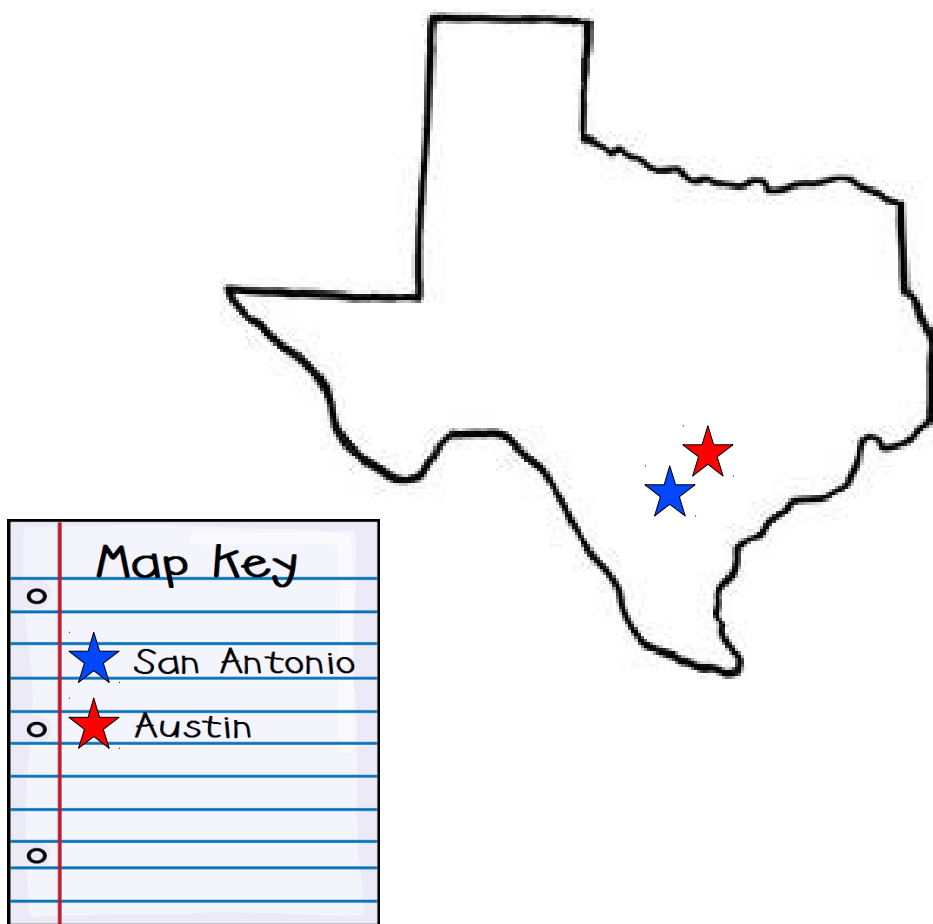


# All About Jose Navarro

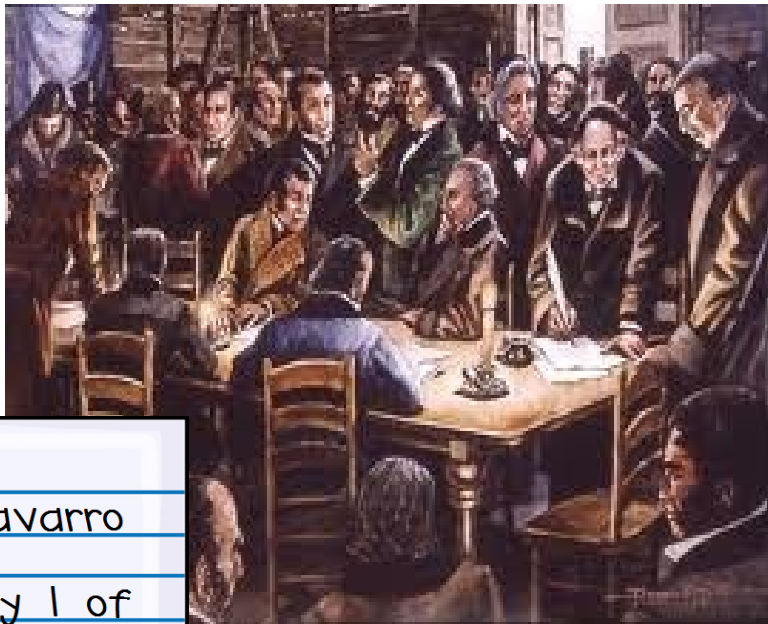


*Texas won the war on March 2, 1836. This meant that Texas did not have to follow the rules of Mexico anymore.*
