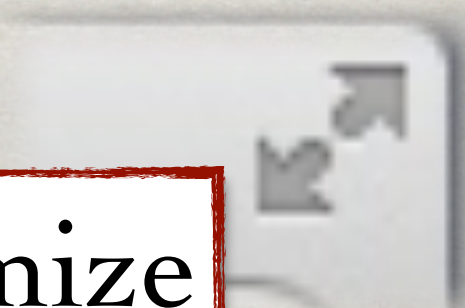

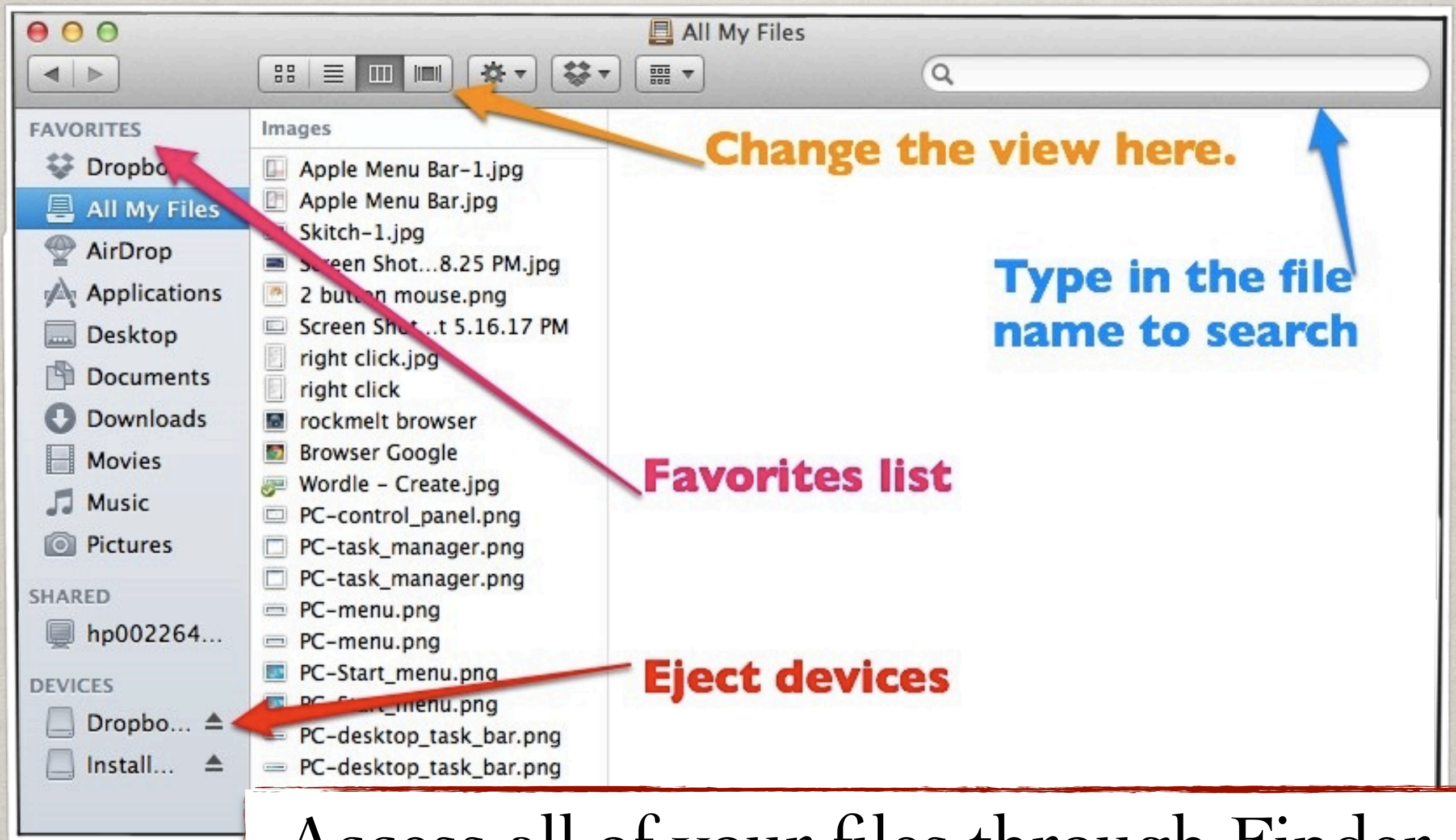
# FINDER

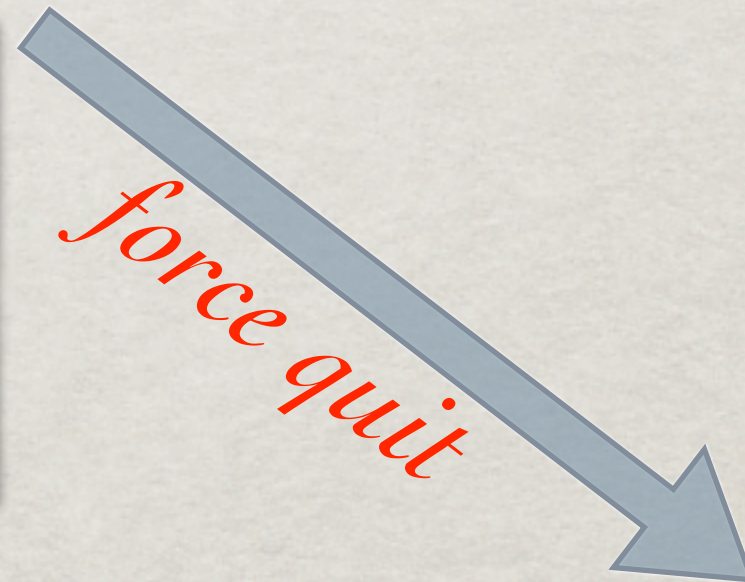

nonworking programs.



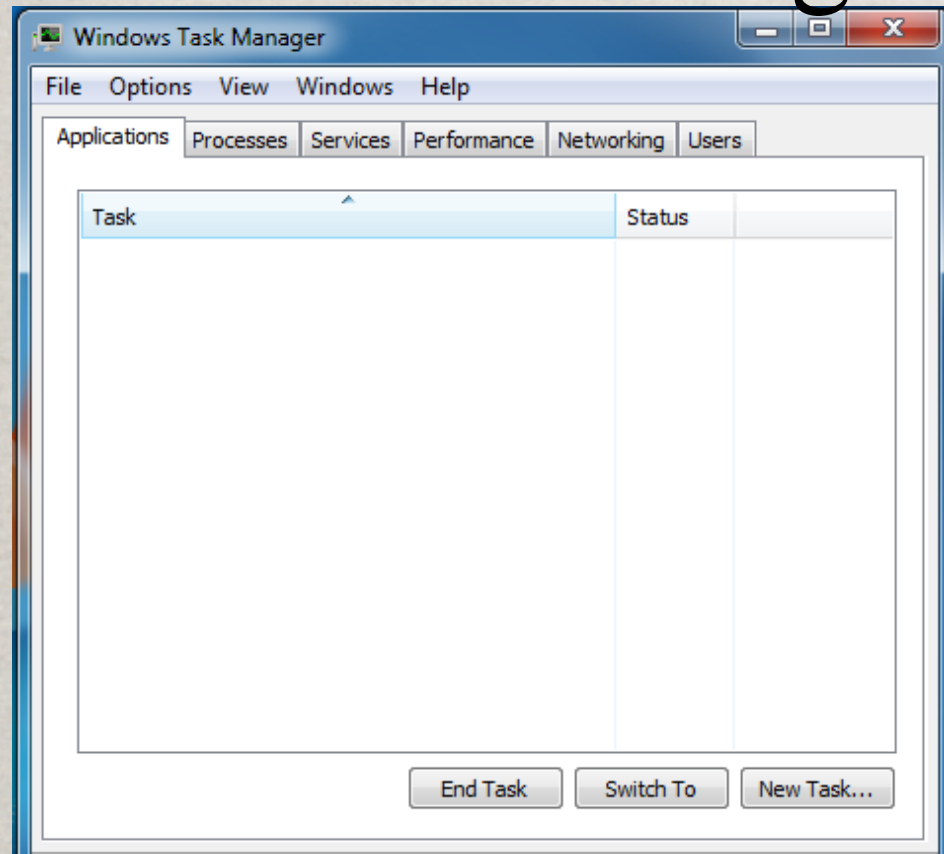
Mac Command

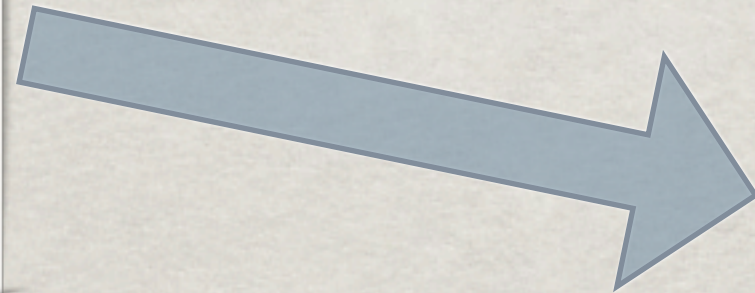

There are two ways to move items to the Trash.



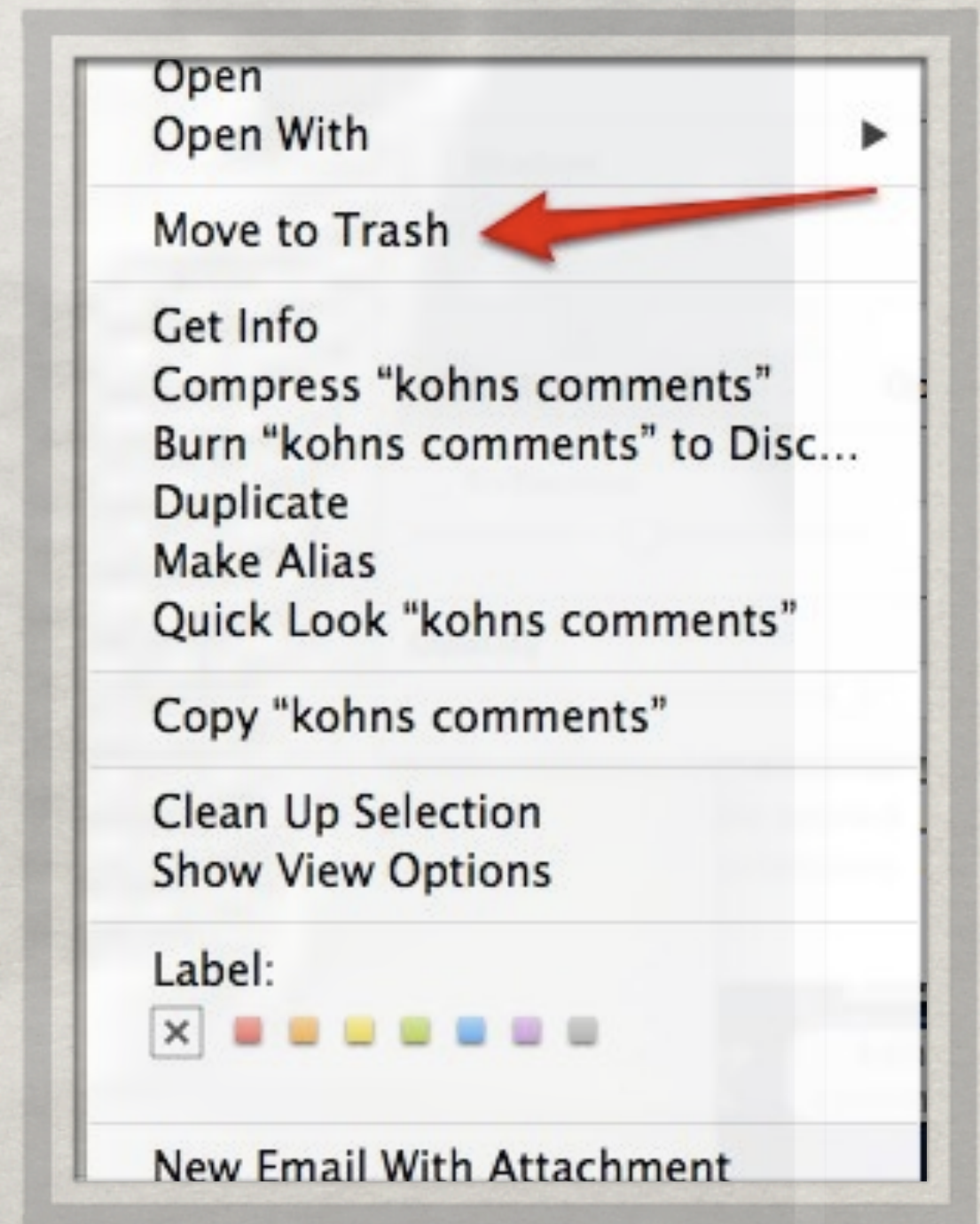

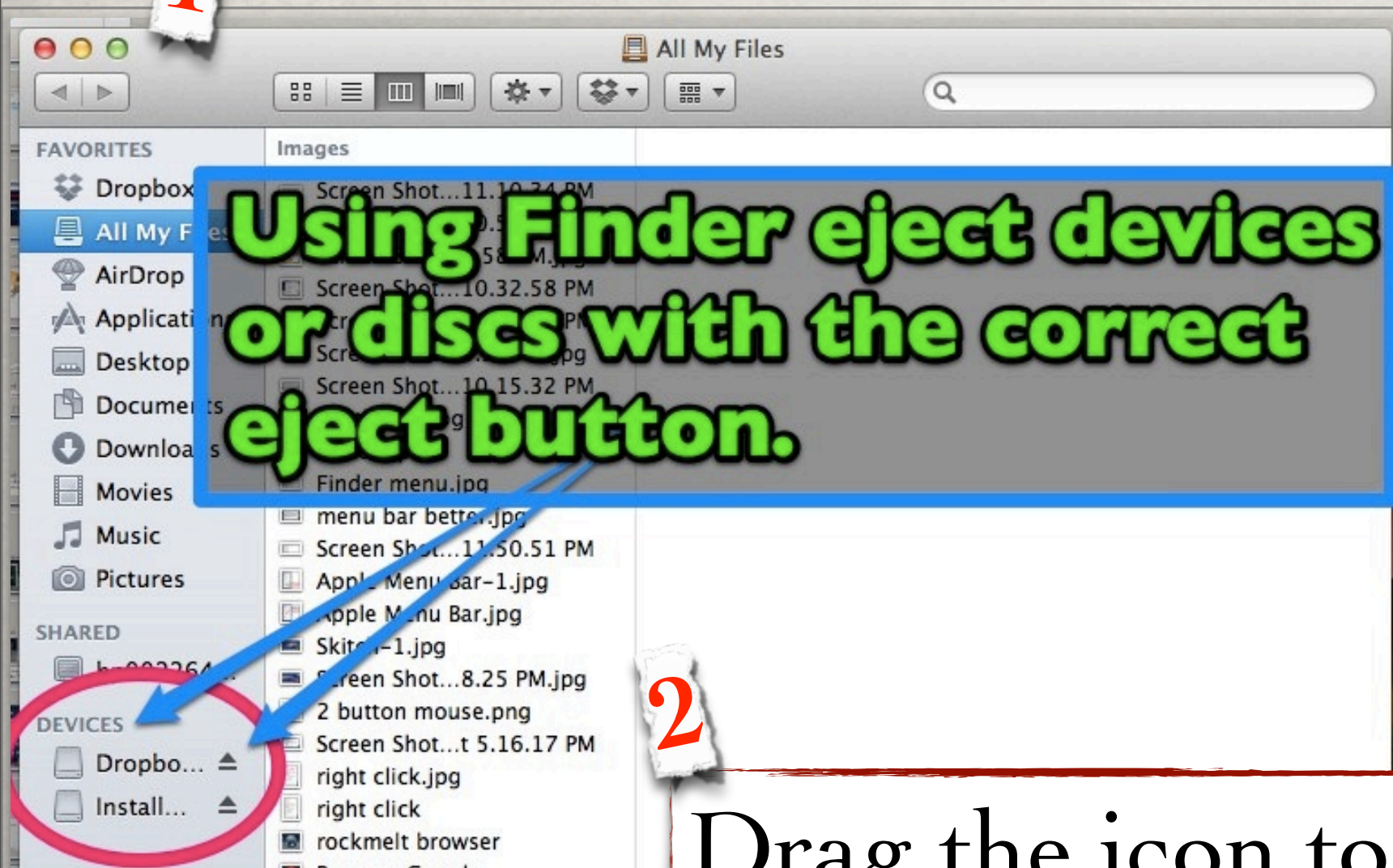
