

## Optional assignment for English II

During the semester, you may turn in ONE optional assignment which is project based. This project must relate in some way to the literature we have read. This assignment will be entered into the computer as a 100-point grade on the assessment side. If you do not want to do this project, your grade will not be affected negatively. If you do choose to do this project, do not wait until the last minute as this will affect the time you have to put into it.
