


The Revolution Through Keynote

Choose one of these events from the American Revolution and dramatize the event through a Keynote Presentation.

Suggested Events:

- ✓ The Battles at Lexington and Concord
- ✓ The Writing and Signing of the Declaration of Independence
- ✓ The Crossing of the Delaware With George Washington
- ✓ The Battle of Bunker Hill
- ✓ The Battle of Saratoga
- ✓ Battle at Yorktown
- ✓ The Winter at Valley Forge
- ✓ The Capture of Fort Ticonderoga



Your project must have at least 12 slides - 10 (ten) slides of information, a Title slide, and a Works Cited slide (correctly cited and annotated).

Expectations:

- Create a project thesis – show your proof or argument of your topic – put this on your title slide.
- Slides should include more primary source information than secondary source information.
- Include: Images, portraits, research, dates, key people and an event outline.
- Correct spelling and grammar – project should be error free.
- Title page – event, thesis and your name (first name only!)
- Include an explanation of why your event is important to the American Revolution
- Explain the background of the key people associated with your event
- Correctly cite and annotate at least 3 primary sources (alphabetical order, separated into primary and secondary sources)
- Use outside sources of information and your textbook as resources (remember to use www.sdlibrary.gov as a resource)
- Plagiarism will result in a zero
- Read, note take and write your research in your own words (to be handed in for a grade)
