

1. **apprehension** - anxiousness; dread
2. **awkwardly** - in a way that lacks skill; clumsily; lacking grace or ease in movement; lacking social graces/manners
3. **bewildered** - completely puzzled or confused; perplexed
4. **bogged down** - sinking under something heavy or stressful; hindered or slowed down by something
5. **convulsive** - shaking violently; agitated; causing to suffer violent muscle spasms
6. **despair** - loss of hope; hopelessness
7. **disgruntled** - displeased and irritated
8. **downcast** - dejected in spirit; depressed
9. **feeble** - physically weak, as from age or sickness; frail; weak intellectually or morally; lacking in volume or brightness
10. **foreboding** - a feeling that something, especially something bad or harmful, is about to happen
11. **forlorn** - abandoned or deserted
12. **frantic** - desperate or wild with excitement, fear, or pain; frenzied
13. **hysterically** - uncontrollably emotional; irrational from fear, emotion, or shock; causing unrestrained crying or laughter
14. **inarticulate** - speechless; not able to be communicated clearly; lacking the ability to express oneself
15. **ineffectually** - not successfully; uselessly
16. **insistent** - demanding something; persistent; requiring immediate attention or notice
17. **intuition** - a knowledge obtained without the conscious use of reasoning; an inner "knowing"
18. **meticulous** - taking or showing extreme care about details; precise; thorough; finicky; fussy
19. **muffled** - wrapped with something to deaden/prevent sound; wrapped to keep warm or protect the face and neck
20. **onslaught** - a violent, intense attack
21. **pandemonium** - chaos; wild disorder, noise or confusion
22. **remorse** - deep and painful regret for wrongdoing
23. **rigid** - stiff or unyielding; not flexible; firmly fixed or set; strict or severe
24. **stealthily** - sneakily; slyly
25. **stricken** - hit or wounded by a weapon, missile, etc.; afflicted with disease, trouble, or sorrow; deeply affected with grief or fear
