Pearson SuccessNet (PSN) provides customers with one access point for all of their Pearson Scott Foresman online products. This guide provides an overview of the SuccessNet content for *Opening the World of Learning (OWL)*.

### Teacher View

After registering at [www.PearsonSuccessNet.com](http://www.PearsonSuccessNet.com), log in with your user name and password. My Teacher Resources is on the left-hand side of the page.



In this area, you can access teacher and student resources. There is also a link to the Interactive Digital Path.

Click on Teacher's Guide to access your online TES, Planning and Assessment Guide, Professional Development Handbook and Lesson Plans. Click on Books and Readers to access online versions of the OWL Big Books and the Ollie and Friends Readers.

### Accessing your OWL online Lesson Plans:

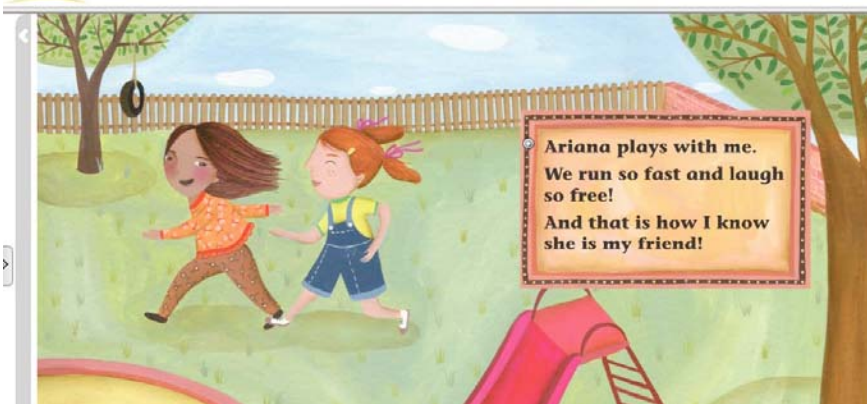
1. Open the Teacher's Guide; select a unit.
2. Open Teacher Resources at the bottom of the Table of Contents on the left side of the screen.
3. Open Lesson Planners folder; select a Unit and a Week.
4. The Lesson Plan will open as a Word document that you can edit, save, email as with any Word file.

### Teacher Resources

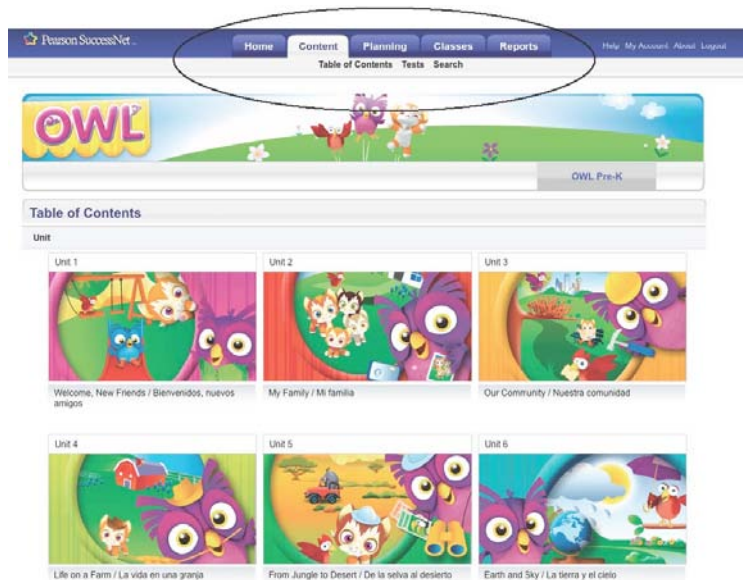

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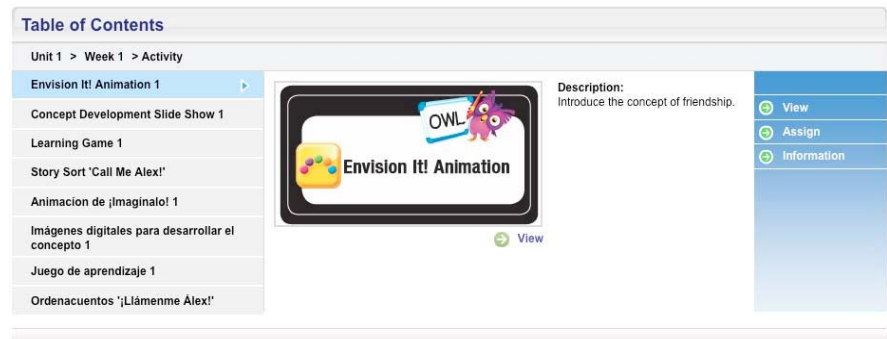


**Books and Readers** Here you will find online versions of the OWL Big Books, Interactive Games, and the Ollie and Friends Readers. Display them on your digital whiteboard or have children read along with the stories from school or home.



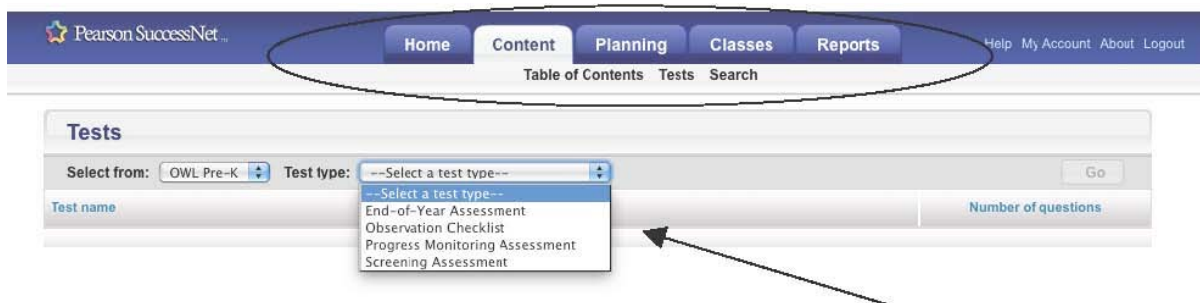
**Interactive Digital Path** The Interactive Digital Path is where you will find the *OWL* games, animations, and other digital teaching tools. After logging in, access the Digital Path from My Teacher Resources or from under the Content tab by clicking on Table of Contents.

Choose a unit and then a week to view and assign the related digital assets. Each week includes an Envision It! Animation, a Concept Development Slide Show, a Learning Game, and a Story Sort in English and Spanish.



### SuccessTracker

In *OWL* Pre-K, SuccessTracker is used for recording and reporting of assessment data. Children do not take tests online. The SuccessTracker system can be accessed under the Content tab by choosing Tests. To record the results of an assessment, choose a test type from the drop down menu and click on Go. (Remember that you can go to [www.MyPearsonTraining.com](http://www.MyPearsonTraining.com) for help in setting up your class.)





Choose the test name for which you wish to record results and then click Assign.

Choose the student(s) for whom you would like to record data and click Save. Once you assign a test to a student, it appears in the student's To-Do List—the assignment list a student sees when he or she enters PSN. For this reason, it is recommended that you do not assign tests to students until right before you are ready to score them.

To enter results for a student, choose Assignments from under the Planning tab. Click on the assignment name and choose Edit/Score.

Click Score/Re-score next to the student's name.

Click on Show Questions. Using the data collected for that child on the related recording form (see your Planning and Assessment Guide), answer the questions about the child's performance on the assessment and assign a score based on the suggested point value. A = 1 point, B = 0 points. When you are finished click Save. This child's assessment data is now saved in the system! Refer to your Planning and Assessment Guide for information on how to use the assessment results for grouping and instruction.

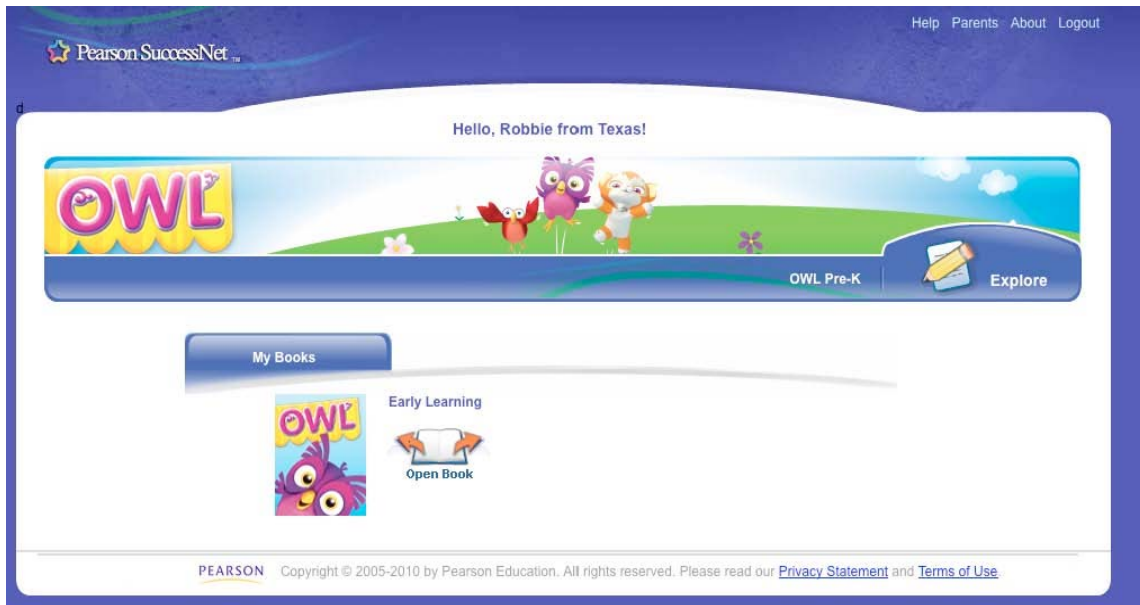

## Student View

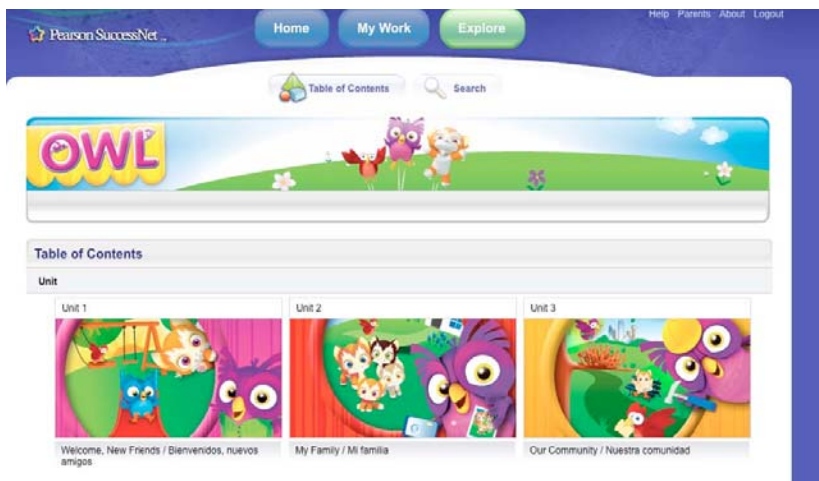
When you set up your class, each student is given a unique user name and password. You can set the user names and passwords, making them easy for children and parents to remember, or the system can assign passwords. Passwords allow children and parents or caregivers, to log in from any computer that is connected to the Internet.

From the student home page, children can access the *OWL* bookstore, located under My Books. Here, children and parents can read, or listen to, the *OWL* Big Books and the Ollie and Friends Readers.
