

Phonological Awareness**Treasure Chest****Onset-Rime****Activity 1:Hear It All!**

To help children begin to hear onset-rimes, model segmenting and blending words.

Example:

1. Say, "Let's stretch the word cat out."
2. Say /k/ (hold one hand out).
3. Say /at/ (hold the other hand out).
4. Say *cat* (place both hands together to represent blending the two sounds).

Here are some other words to try:

- a. mom
- b. dad
- c. rat
- d. lock
- e. book
- f. kit
- g. sock
