

## Activity 4.7.8

# Alliterative Picture Book

### Setting

- Whole or small group

### Materials

- pairs of pictures that begin with the same sound. Each pair should begin with a different different sound.

### Define concept in child friendly terms

You can make a book out of pictures that all begin with the same letter or sound as in your name. Each person's will be different, depending on the first letter in their name.

### Model and explain procedure

**Today, each of you will make your own book of pictures based on the beginning letter/sound of your name. You will choose your pictures with me. While you are waiting to choose your pictures with me, you will draw a picture of yourself for the cover.**

Provide pictures that represent the different beginning sounds of the children's names in the class. Have children come up one at a time and help (if needed) them choose pictures that show alliteration with their first name.

Have the children choose 2-3 pictures that have the same beginning sound as their name and create their own book.

Example: Dorothy's book would have her picture on page 1. Other pages would include pictures that start with the /d/ sound such as dog, dish, etc.

### Guided practice

The children will glue their pictures in their books.

Have the children share their books with each other.

### Summarize

**Today we made books with pictures that sound the same as the beginning letter of our first name.**
