

CHURCH ETIQUETTE

Worship is the time when the people of GOD come before HIS presence as a community of faith. As such, it should be thusly regarded with great seriousness and sacredness. The things listed below will assist in preparing for the blessing to be received during, and after, the Worship Service.

- ♦ **COME** on time.
- ♦ **COME** regularly.
- ♦ **DRESS** as if you are going to meet the **LORD**.
- ♦ **BRING** your **BIBLE**.
- ♦ **BRING** your **TITHES** and **OFFERING**, and present them unto the **LORD**.
- ♦ **BEGAN** to worship before you get to church by praying to and praising **GOD** at home, and while on your way to Church.
- ♦ **DO NOT WALK** unnecessarily especially during the sermon, scripture reading, invitation, prayer, choir's singing, and generally whenever someone is speaking.
- ♦ **PLACE** all phones, pagers, etc. on vibrate or off.
- ♦ **DO NOT TALK** unnecessarily. It disturbs others and the sanctity of Worship.
- ♦ **DO NOT EAT or CHEW** gum, candy, etc. during worship.
- ♦ **DO NOT LEAVE** all the singing to the choir. Lift up your voices as well (in praise) during the congregational hymns.
- ♦ **DO NOT LEAVE** all the preaching to the preacher. Support the preacher with your vocal, and visible responses.
- ♦ **DO NOT LEAVE** before the Benediction. This is the final blessing, and you will not want to miss this
- ♦ **DO NOT** leave the **LORD** in the Sanctuary when you depart. Take the name of Jesus with you, and serve the community for **CHRIST**.
