This is your introduction. It should have a sentence or two to introduce your topic. Your thesis statement is the last sentence of the introduction.

In the topic sentence of your second paragraph you should state your first argument. The next few sentences should give evidence, examples and/ or additional supporting information.

In the topic sentence of your third paragraph you should state your second argument. The next few sentences should give evidence, examples and/ or additional supporting information.

The fourth paragraph is the counter argument. The topic sentence should introduce an argument or two that people who disagree with you would make. Your last sentence or two should be your refutation, that is, why the counter argument is wrong.

You use the conclusion to rephrase the question, summarize your arguments, summarize the main ideas, and/or look to the future by saying what you think might happen if your arguments are or are not accepted.
