"I'm still trying to figure out how to set some hot keys (like spacebar for capture frame)."

Answer

See *TVPaint 10 User Manual*, Lesson 1 - section 1-2 - through - 1-20 on the PREFERENCES panel, see the part under the "General" tab -- Keyboard shorts : Configure . When you click on the "Configure" button it will bring up a window with the Keys listed the Left column and the Keyboard commands (shortcuts) listed in the Right column.

To create your own shortcuts, click on the Configure button in the second section.

You have probably noticed that when the InLine help appears, many tools, options, drawing modes, etc. already have associated keyboard shortcuts : don't hesitate to change them if they don't suit you. Any modification in that panel will cause a modification in the InLine help.

- The left-hand column indicates all keyboard keys and key combinations with the associated functions when attributed.
- The right-hand column indicates all TVPaint Animation functions which may be attributed to a keyboard shortcut.
- The Assign button is used to assign a function to a specific key or combination of keys (in which case you will create a shortcut for this function). The combination [Ctrl] + Assign is used to add a function to a key. The various functions will be executed in the order they were added.
- The Unassign button has the opposite effect (in this case it deletes the shortcut).
- The File popup menu is used to save the keymap on your hard drive, load an existing keymap,

clear the current keymap or reset to the default keymap.
