"I'm on a MAC. Should I use the 64 or 32 bit TVP ?

***Anyone else who is using TVPaint 10 on MAC computer please note:**

At one time there was an issue with the 64bit version for Mac being a little 'buggy' , but as of the most recent updates the 64bit version seems to be working fine.
Just be sure that you have all the UPDATES .. up to date...
check w the TVP website for Updates.. even if you just installed from the disc you got in the mail!

Students should however be aware that if they want to use the freeware webcam control software CamTwist that it will only work with the 32bit version of TVPaint (CamTwist is 32bit only , has not been updated to work on 64bit)

Both the 32bit version of TVPaint and 64bit version of TVPaint can be loaded on on the same computer if desired. There's no conflict between having both versions installed .

Here is the older message about the bug with earlier versions of TVP

If you currently have TVPaint 10 *64bit version* (you can check the version under the Help Menu -- 'About TVPaint Animation') then you should download the 32bit version for Mac here:

You will have to enter your Lock Code (the longer 14 char. code, both letters and numbers) , Unlock Code (6 letter code), Your Name, then select :

Platform: Mac OSX

Processor: x86(Intel)

Architecture: **32bits**

Download it and install it into a separate New folder named "TVPaint 10 32bit" in your Applications folder.

Running the 32bit version for Mac should clear up any problems with Video Input settings.
